SUMMARY

This item is for the acceptance of the Eastern Research Group, Inc. (ERG) Organizational Audit of the Air Quality Management Division and possible direction from the Board of Health.

PREVIOUS ACTION

BACKGROUND

Northern Nevada Public Health (NNPH) recognized the need for an assessment of the Air Quality Management Division and its business practices. Eastern Research Group, Inc. (ERG) conducted the audit and compiled the attached report.

The audit aimed to evaluate AQMD's strengths, weaknesses, and challenges across key areas. These key areas included:

- Permit actions and compliance with federal, state, and local regulations and requirements.
- Compliance and enforcement actions, metrics, and policies.
- Transparency in operations and responsiveness to community needs, including environmental justice (EJ) opportunities and best practices.
- Overall operational efficiencies and business practices.

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The audit was designed to identify areas for improvement and opportunities to enhance AQMD's efficiency, effectiveness, and service delivery. Additionally, the project developed actionable recommendations to help AQMD improve both internally and externally in delivering its services.
