Administrative Office of the Courts to fund a contractor to supplement the court's Information Technology (IT) team in the conversion of the case

### **SUMMARY**

This award will fund a contractor to supplement the court's IT team in the implementation and data migration of the existing Case Management System (CMS) into a new, modern CMS which will improve efficiency in case processing and support electronic access.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Efficient Delivery of Regional Services

#### PREVIOUS ACTION

Original award of \$3,673.96 received consent at the May 13, 2025, meeting.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Second Judicial District Court (SJDC) is currently using outdated and unsupported CMS which was implemented in 1998. Working with the Nevada Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC), a new vendor was selected through an RFP process, and the Court has been taking the necessary steps towards implementation and transition since 2023. SJDC was scheduled to go live with the new CMS the first week of November 2025 and as with any new system of this magnitude, it has now been pushed back to February of 2026, as a result there continues to be a concerted effort from the IT team, court staff, and

the vendor to keep the conversion on task while still maintaining day to day technology needs of the Court.
