

- Dental care


Animals:

Options Veterinary Care

The Washoe County ARPA funds for Options are used to provide:

- Free TNR spay/neuter for cats trapped in Washoe County
- Free spay/neuter for Washoe County rescue groups
- Affordable and free spay/neuter for Washoe County pet owners

ARPA funded spay/neuter surgeries at Options include:



- Free vaccine - canine (DAPPv) or feline (HPC) - courtesy of Petco Love.
- Free Rabies vaccine courtesy of Options supporters.
- Free microchips courtesy of Washoe County.



Options Veterinary Care

From December 10, 2024 - December 31, 2025*

Options has performed 4,349 spay/neuter surgeries.

Total: 4,349

- **Dogs: 740**
- **Cats: 3,608**
- **Rabbits: 1**



Options Veterinary Care

Spay/Neuter Surgeries at Options December 10, 2024 – December 31, 2025

Total Spay/Neuter Surgeries: 4,349



In order to help ensure funds go as far as possible, Options works with clients to determine individual financial need and the best way to meet their needs.

Options Veterinary Care

Spay/neuter surgeries (Dec. 10, 2024 – Dec. 31, 2025)

Washoe County ARPA Funding provided: 1,592

- 37% of total s/n at Options
- WC ARPA program reimburses Options \$62.50 per spay/neuter surgery under this program

Options Veterinary Care

Spay/neuter surgeries (Dec. 10, 2024 – Dec. 31, 2025)

SPCA of Northern Nevada Voucher Program

provided: 249

- 6% of total
- Covers all of Northern Nevada
 - 160 Dogs
 - 89 Cats



Options Veterinary Care

Spay/neuter surgeries (Dec. 10, 2024 – Dec. 31, 2025)

Other – owner paid or funded by other programs: 2,508

- 57% of total

Includes s/n paid for by:

- Owners - Options lower rates are affordable for some
- Rescue groups from outside Washoe County - not eligible for ARPA or SPCA programs
- Other funds/donors



Options Veterinary Care

Focusing on the 1,592 spay/neuter surgeries made possible by Washoe County ARPA funds:

Dogs: 163

- Roughly 40% of the dog owners paid something toward their dog's care, usually to cover additional needed care.
- Roughly 60% did not pay anything.

Options Veterinary Care

Focusing on the 1,592 spay/neuter surgeries made possible by Washoe County ARPA funds:

Cats: 1,429 total

- 773 community cats (54%)
- 656 companion cats (46%)
- 8% of the cat owners and colony caregivers paid something toward the cat's care, usually to cover additional needed care.
