

RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Michael Clark for District 2, has determined that \$5,000.00 will be granted to Mustangs of America Foundation to support the Bureau of Land Management with the Northern Nevada Correctional Center's wild horse training program; and

WHEREAS, Mustangs of America Foundation is dedicated, all volunteer organization committed to the welfare of mustangs and burros. Focusing on collaboration with the Bureau of Land Management to enhance successful adoptions; and

WHEREAS, Mustangs of America Foundation's vision is a world where mustangs and burros can roam freely, cherished and protected. Where these majestic creatures are valued for their beauty, spirit, and integral role in the ecosystem; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to Mustangs of America Foundation a grant for fiscal year 2025-2026 to in the amount of \$5,000.00.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
4. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution's approval.
