PREVIOUS ACTION

Donations are made to the Regional Parks and Open Space programs and facilities and formally accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.

BACKGROUND

The residents of Washoe County support our parks, open space and natural resources through their generous cash contributions, donations of materials, supplies and services and volunteer time. Cash donations, in the amount of \$18,809.87 have been received for park maintenance, improvements, programming, and to assist with the safety and comfort for Washoe County residents, therefore, retroactive approval to accept these donations is being sought.

Cash donations received at this time are dedicated to general donations to the Lazy 5 Summer Music Series, Galena Creek Iron Rangers, Discovery Room, tree and brick donations and general maintenance support for the Arboretum and general donation support to the May Museum.
