

RESOLUTION: R26-69

Authorizing grant of funds to RENO INITIATIVE FOR SHELTER AND EQUALITY

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities created for religious, charitable or educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County has determined that a certain amount of money is available from the Washoe Opioid Abatement and Recovery Funds (WOARF), award number WOARF27-00005, through the One Nevada Agreement on Allocation of Opioid Recoveries, passed through to RENO INITIATIVE FOR SHELTER AND EQUALITY for the CROSSROADS FAMILIES program which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of Washoe County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY, that the Board hereby awards

1. RENO INITIATIVE FOR SHELTER AND EQUALITY, a grant in the amount of \$1,288,670.
2. The purpose of the WOARF funded program is to operate the CROSSROADS FAMILIES program in partnership with Washoe County Human Services Agency. This program provides a facility where parents reside with their children to engage in recovery together. The program addresses the needs of families impacted by opioid use disorder (OUD) through a comprehensive, family-centered approach implementing child welfare best practices to support family stability, promote family reunification and prevent child removals.
3. The maximum amount to be expended from the grant and the conditions and limitations upon the award are set forth in Notice of Award WOARF27-00005 that will be signed by the Purchasing & Contracts Manager, or designee
