SUMMARY

Accept donations in the amount of \$17,797.70 in cash from various businesses, organizations and individuals for Regional Parks and Open Space programs and facilities and accept in-kind donations from May Arboretum Society valued at \$18,330.71 in support of the May Arboretum, retroactive to date of receipt.

PREVIOUS ACTION

Donations are made to the Regional Parks and Open Space programs and facilities and formally accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.

BACKGROUND

The residents of Washoe County support our parks, open space and natural resources through their generous cash contributions, donations of materials, supplies and services and volunteer time. Cash donations, in the amount of \$17,797.70 have been received for park maintenance, improvements, programming, and to assist with the safety and comfort for Washoe County residents, therefore, retroactive approval to accept these donations is being sought.

Cash donations received at this time are dedicated to general donations to the Bowers Mansion Iron Rangers, Lazy 5 Summer Music Series Sponsorships, and general donations to the May Museum. Estimated values of in-kind donations received include May Arboretum Society for staff support.
