

RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Government Entity.

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Mariluz Garcia for District 3, has determined that \$1,000.00 will be granted to Procter Hug High School – a government entity – to support the leadership class and their efforts to get the youth involved in the community; and

WHEREAS, Procter Hug High School’s mission is to create college and career-ready individuals through the power of knowledge, integrity, and diversity while maintaining rigorous and supportive academics; and

WHEREAS, Procter Hug High School’s leadership class encourages youth to create a positive space to learn how to be leaders in the community; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to Procter Hug High School Leadership program, a grant for fiscal year 2024-2025 in the amount of \$1,000.00.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County by providing area youth personal growth opportunities that will impact them as future leaders throughout their lifetimes.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
4. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution’s approval.
