Looking to get more involved in shaping Washoe County's future? Check out some of our boards and commissions that are accepting applications. Details for each opening are below:

Open Space & Parks Commission

The purpose of the Parks Commission is to act in an advisory capacity to the Board of County Commissioners. Examples of items that come before the Board include District and Park Master Plans; schedule of priorities for acquisition and development of park property; purchase, lease or exchange of lands for recreation or park purposes; and rates and charges for services and facility use. This position is for a partial term beginning on the date of appointment and ending on June 30, 2027. Thereafter, the member may seek an additional consecutive term. The Commission meets on the fourth Wednesday of every other month at 1:30 p.m. (January, March, May, July, September, November). Members receive no compensation. Apply online or pick up a printed application at the Washoe County Manager's Office. Deadline to apply is 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 15, 2026. Spanish Springs/District 4 Citizens Advisory Board

Citizen Advisory Boards (CABs) are organized meetings held on a regular basis for the purpose of bringing community members together to discuss topics of interest within their neighborhood, express ideas and concerns to Washoe County staff, and hear from subject matter experts. CABs adhere to open meeting law. There are current openings on the Spanish Springs/District 4 Citizens Advisory Board. Applications are ongoing.

Note: Individuals who have applied to any of the above boards/committees within one year of the application deadline do not need to reapply.
