**RESOLUTION** – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Government Entity.

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Jeanne Herman for District 5, has determined that \$5,000.00 will be granted to Spanish Springs High School – a government entity – to support the Spanish Springs High School JROTC program; and

**WHEREAS,** Spanish Springs High School JROTC's mission is to motivate young people to be citizens of character by instilling in them a sense of personal responsibility, accomplishment and the importance of serving their nation and community; and

**WHEREAS,** Spanish Springs High School JROTC battalion has been active for the 20 years that Spanish Springs High School has been open; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

- 1. The Board hereby grants to Spanish Springs High School JROTC program, a grant for fiscal year 2024-2025 in the amount of \$5,000.00.
- The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to
  the residents in Washoe County by providing area youth personal and leadership opportunities
  that will impact them as future leaders throughout their lifetimes.
- 3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.

4. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution's approval.
