Why are you interested in being part of this board/commission or academy?

I'm interested in being a part of this commission in an effort to become more involved in the Washoe County community. Originally from Pennsylvania, I moved to Nevada in July 2014 to attend graduate school at UNR and I've been a resident of Washoe County ever since. I have four children (three biological and one foster child) with my oldest son currently attending Indiana State University, my younger son and my foster son both getting ready to graduate from McQueen High School after which my son will head to McPherson College in Kansas and my foster son is enrolled at TMCC, and my daughter will be entering her junior year at McQueen next year where she cheers and runs track. As my children get older, I'm interested in using some of the extra time I'm afforded to become more involved in improving my community and believe that my educational background as well as my personal and professional experience can provide some value to the Washoe County Planning Commission.

I hold a BS in Geology and an MS in Hydrogeology and have always had a love of the physical/natural sciences and the outdoors. Upon completing my research and defending my Masters thesis at UNR, I worked in the geothermal industry as a wellsite geologist in The Geysers of Northern California and on The Big Island of Hawaii, but have been employed by the State of Nevada for the last six years. I began my career in government service with Nevada's Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation where I was a Permit Writer for the Reclamation Branch where I reviewed reclamation permits which included a focus on short- and long-term post-mining land use. For the last two and a half years, I've been a Project Manager and Fluid Minerals Program Specialist for the Nevada Division of Minerals which reports to the Nevada Commission on Mineral Resources. In my current role, I coordinate educational and community/public outreach events, teach lessons in K-12 classrooms, compile informational publications for both industry and public audiences, assist NDOM's Fluid Minerals Program in reviewing geothermal, oil and gas, and dissolved mineral exploration permit applications, performing inspections, and enforcing compliance actions, and assist NDOM's Abandoned Mine Lands program with public service announcement campaigns and field work related to public health and safety with respect to historical mine hazards, overseeing interns during AML field work, and many other NDOM projects. I've worked with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), US Forest Service (USFS), National Parks Service (NPS), Nevada Bureau of Mines and Geology (NBMG), Desert Research Institute (DRI), Nevada Division of Water Resources (NDWR), Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP), and myriad other agencies on various projects during my time in State service. I think my education and experience as a geologist/hydrogeologist, my professional background in environmental permitting across multiple industries, and being a member of the Washoe County community with a desire to be involved make me well-qualified to serve on the Commission.
