PREVIOUS ACTION

On January 08, 2019 the Board approved item #8E1, the acceptance of the Child Abuse and Neglect (CANS) sub-grant award in the amount of \$22,049 retroactive for the period of June 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.

On April 24, 2018 the Board approved item #8D2, the acceptance of the Child Abuse and Neglect (CANS) sub-grant award in the amount of \$2,000 for March 1, 2018 through September 30, 2018.

BACKGROUND

The State of Nevada Division of Child and Family Services receives Child Abuse and Neglect State Grants (CANS) awards as authorized under Title 1, Section 106 of the Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA). Funding under CANS is established to support and improve child protective services systems.

CANS has a variety of applications, and the intended use is determined on a state-by-state basis each award cycle. Eligible activities and services can apply to intake, assessment, screening, and investigating, and can support initiatives such as training and skill development, case management, and technology.

This grant award will support two projects. First, is the development of advanced skills through training that will benefit the assessment and investigation of child abuse and neglect reports and enhance collaboration through multi-disciplinary teams (MDT). Second, is to support and improve the capabilities of staff to efficiently, accurately, and timely document and manage work from the field.

The Agency received the Notice of Sub-Award for this grant on November 7, 2025 with an effective date of July 1, 2025; therefore, the request to accept this award is retroactive.
