

RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Alexis Hill for District 1, has determined that \$15,000.00 will be granted to the Incline Village Crystal Bay Community and Business Association (IVCBA) -- a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- for the purpose of supporting the Incline Village Main Street program and other community engagements; and

WHEREAS, the IVCBA is a local community and business association dedicated to building and growing cohesiveness for the sustainability of Incline Village and Crystal Bay; and

WHEREAS, the Incline Village Main Street program, through IVCBA, will establish several community connection initiatives that aid Washoe County in their efforts to advance redevelopment and housing initiatives outlined in the Tahoe Area Plan; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to the Incline Village Crystal Bay Community & Business Association (IVCBA), to support funding of the Incline Village Main Street program, a grant for fiscal year 2025-2026 in the amount of \$15,000.00.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
4. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution's approval.
