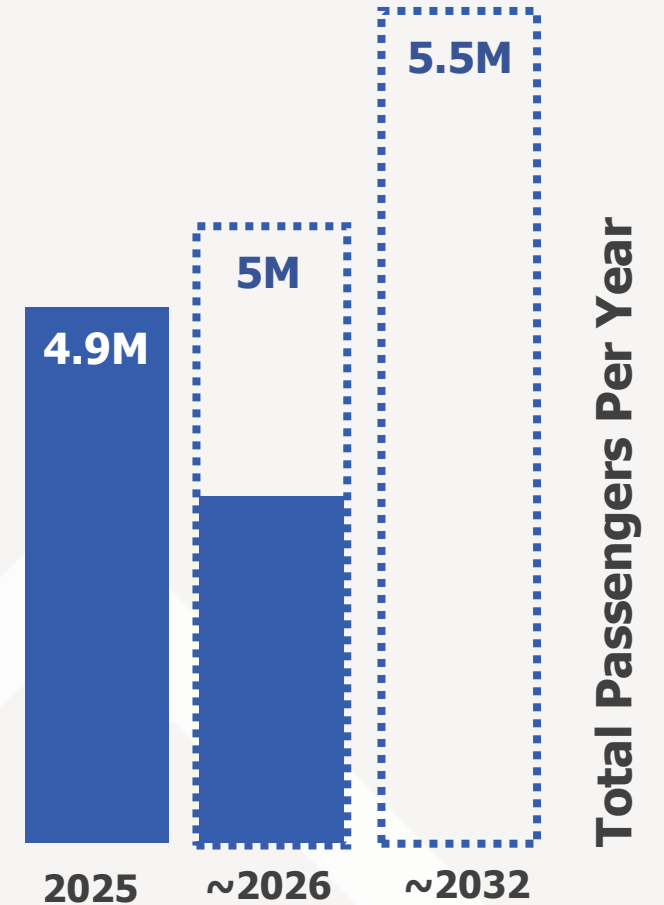

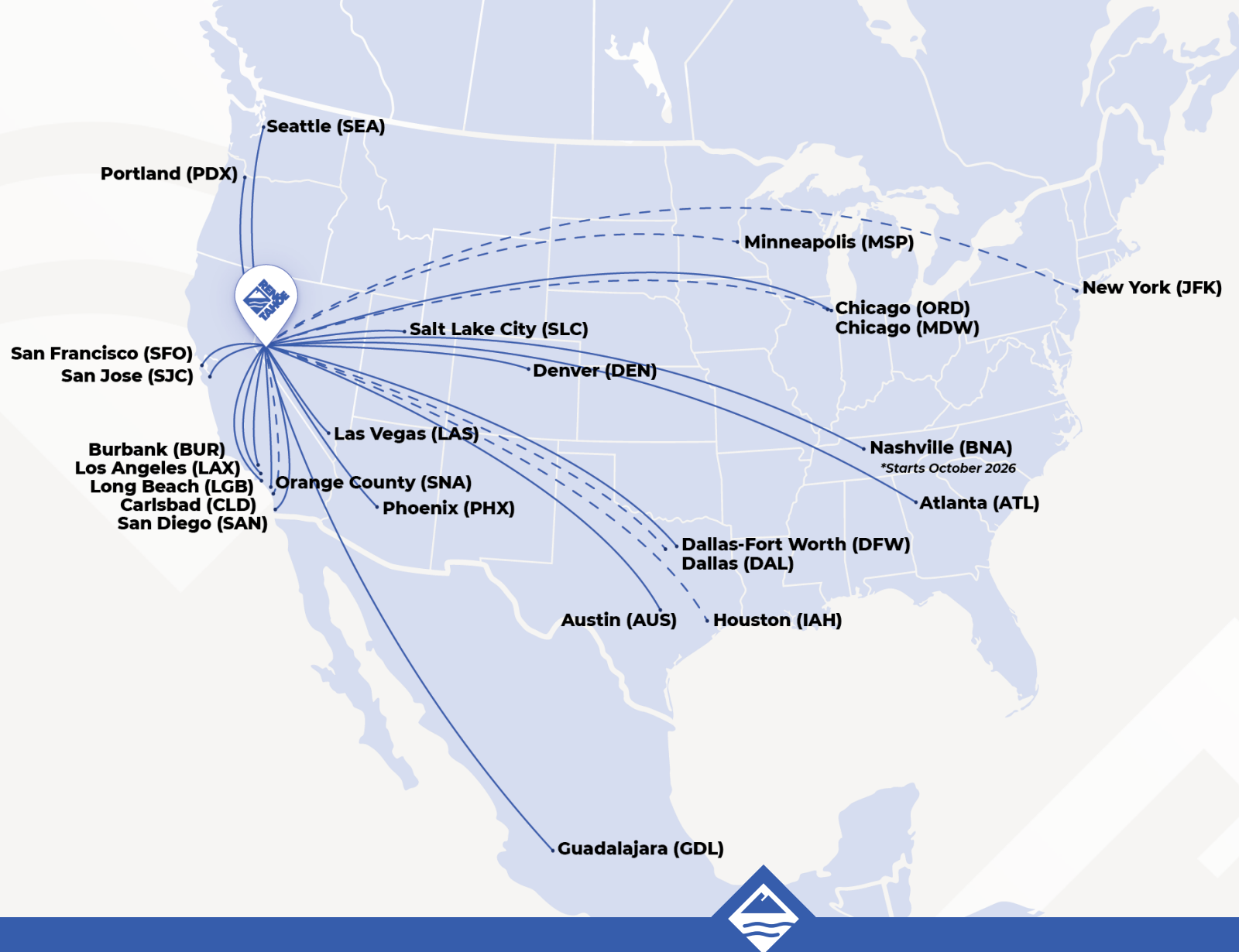


# RNO Passenger Projections

- 2025 finished with 4.9 million passengers
  - The best year since 2008 (4.4 million)
- RNO served 2.35 million passengers the first half of 2026, a 2.2% increase compared to last year
- 2026 is expected to finish with 5 million total passengers, surpassing the previous year

# Projects Underway

## Police and Airport Authority Headquarters (The HQ)

- Construction Started: September 2025
- Expected Completion: 2027
- Improvements:
  - Quicker airside and landside response for Airport Police Department
  - Important in-terminal admin space released for tenant use
  - 60% local trade partner bids, showcasing strong regional support and investment

## Ground Transportation Center

- Public-Private-Partnership with Conrac Solutions
- Enabling Projects Under Construction
- Construction Started: October 2025
- Expected Completion: 2028
- Expected Improvements:
  - Ground transit experience

  - Reclaim ~600 parking spaces in parking garage

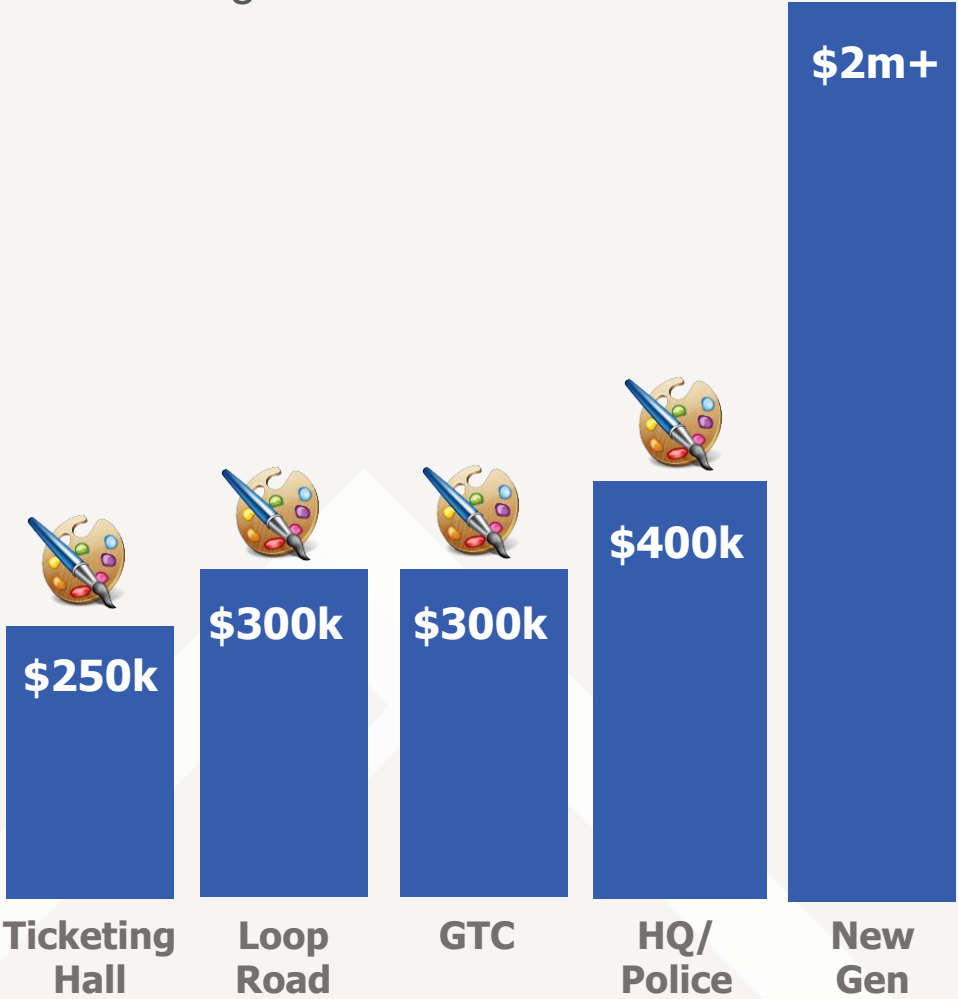
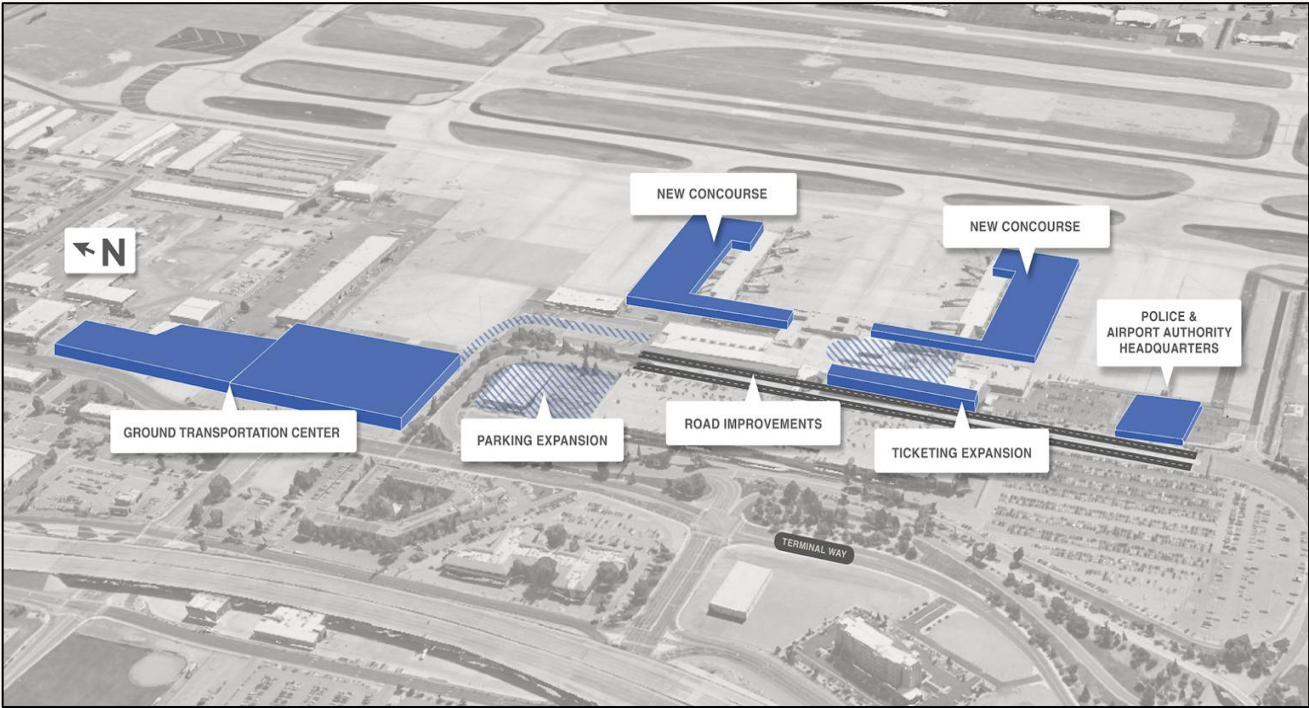

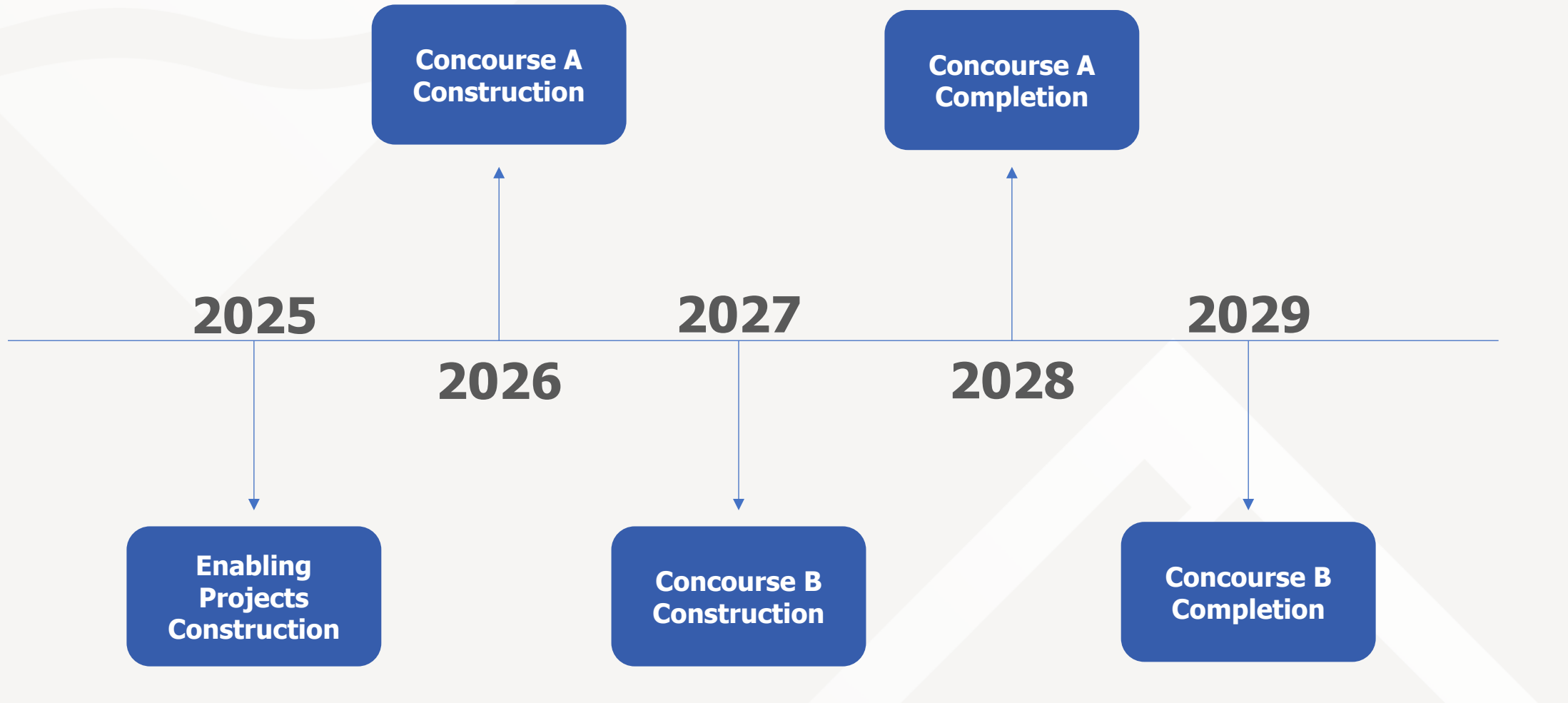
