2/2: TMFR Crews knocked down a small house fire contained to contents inside a closet on Red Sky Lane in Hungry Valley.

2/11: TMFR & Reno Fire crews knocked down a house fire on Riata Circle in south Reno. Five occupants were displaced.

2/23: TMFR Firefighters knocked down an RV fire on Smokey Canyon Road in Sun Valley.

2/16-20: TMFR Crews were busy responding to multiple motor vehicle accidents from a major winter storm that pounded the region.

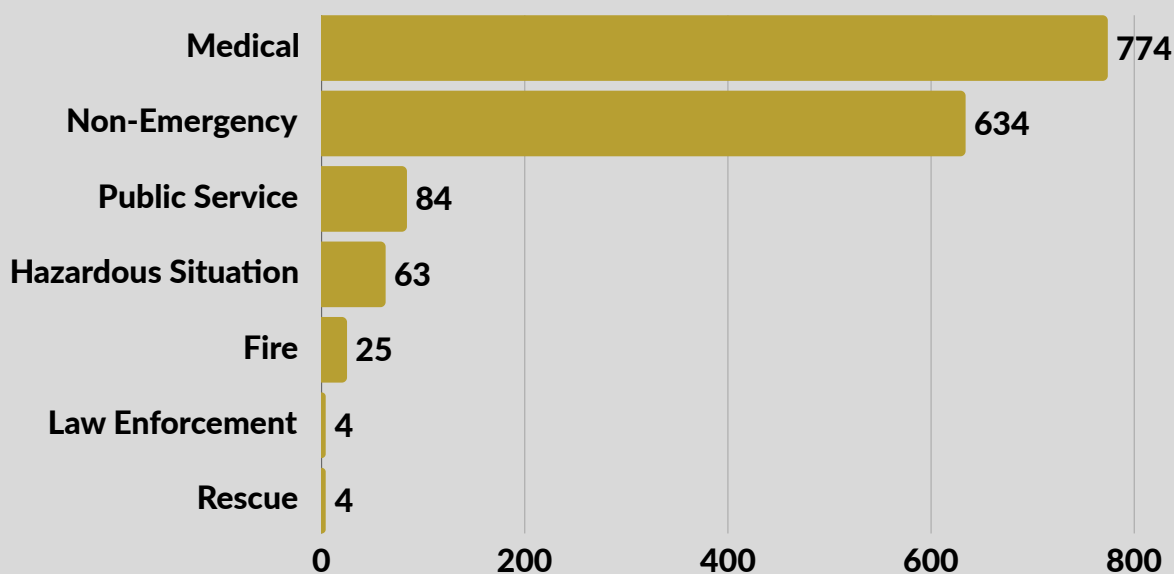

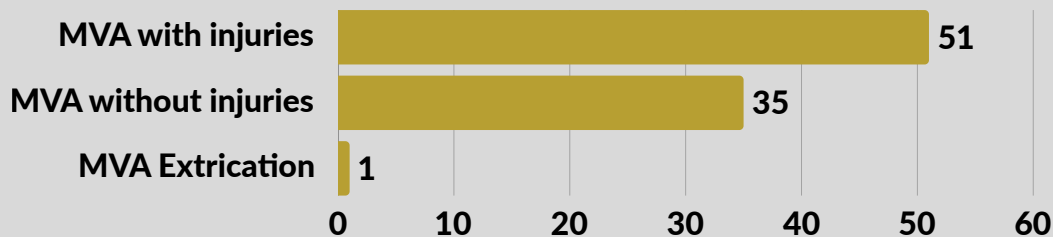
Incident Statistics

Statistics and categories reflect the start of a new TMFPD and National reporting system that began January 1, 2026. TMFPD transitioned its reporting system to align with the National Emergency Response Information System (NERIS) to ensure uninterrupted national data reporting and compliance. NERIS replaced the 50-year old coding and manual data entry system known as NFIRS and expanded the capabilities to include all-hazard reporting with real-time data and improved interoperability.

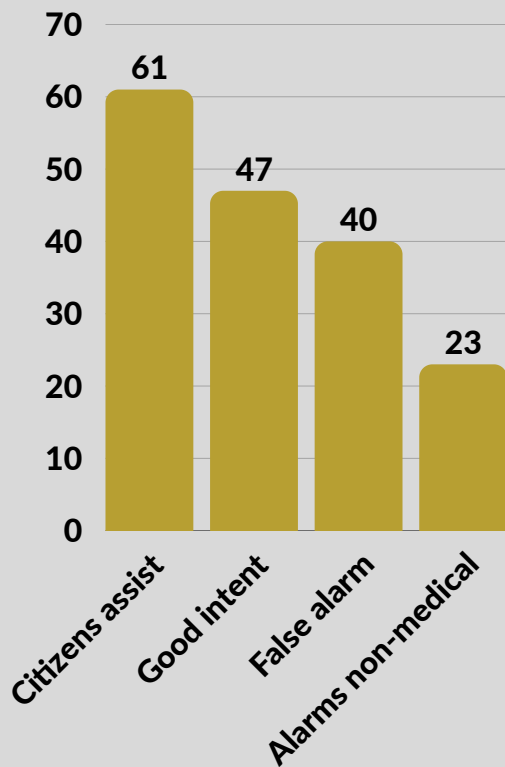


Motor Vehicle Accident (MVA) Detail: 87





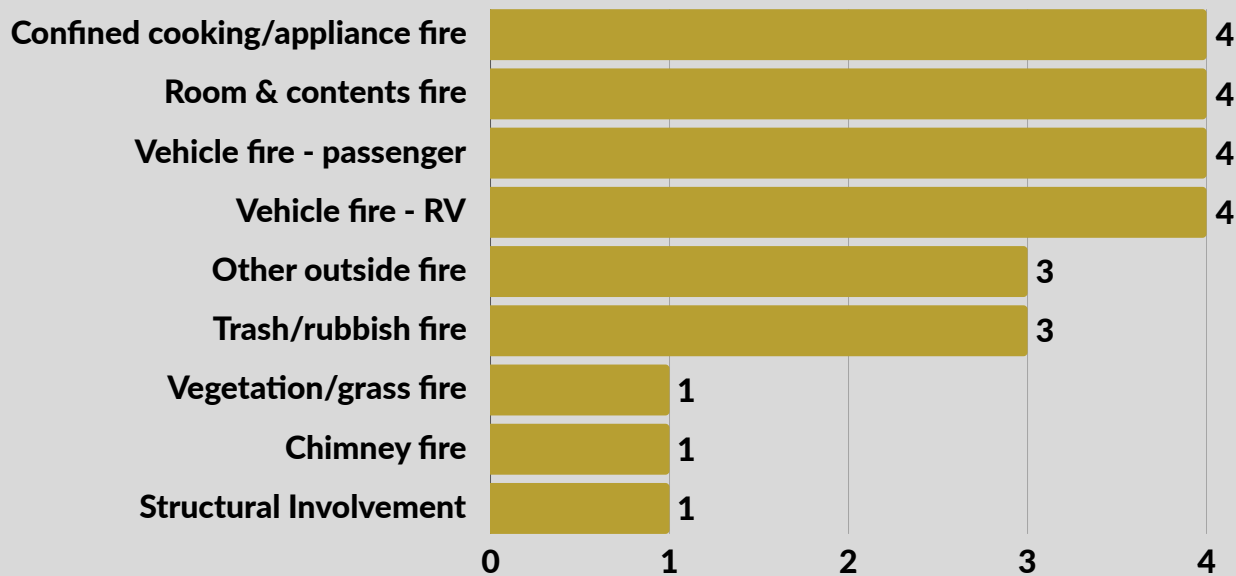

Call Types

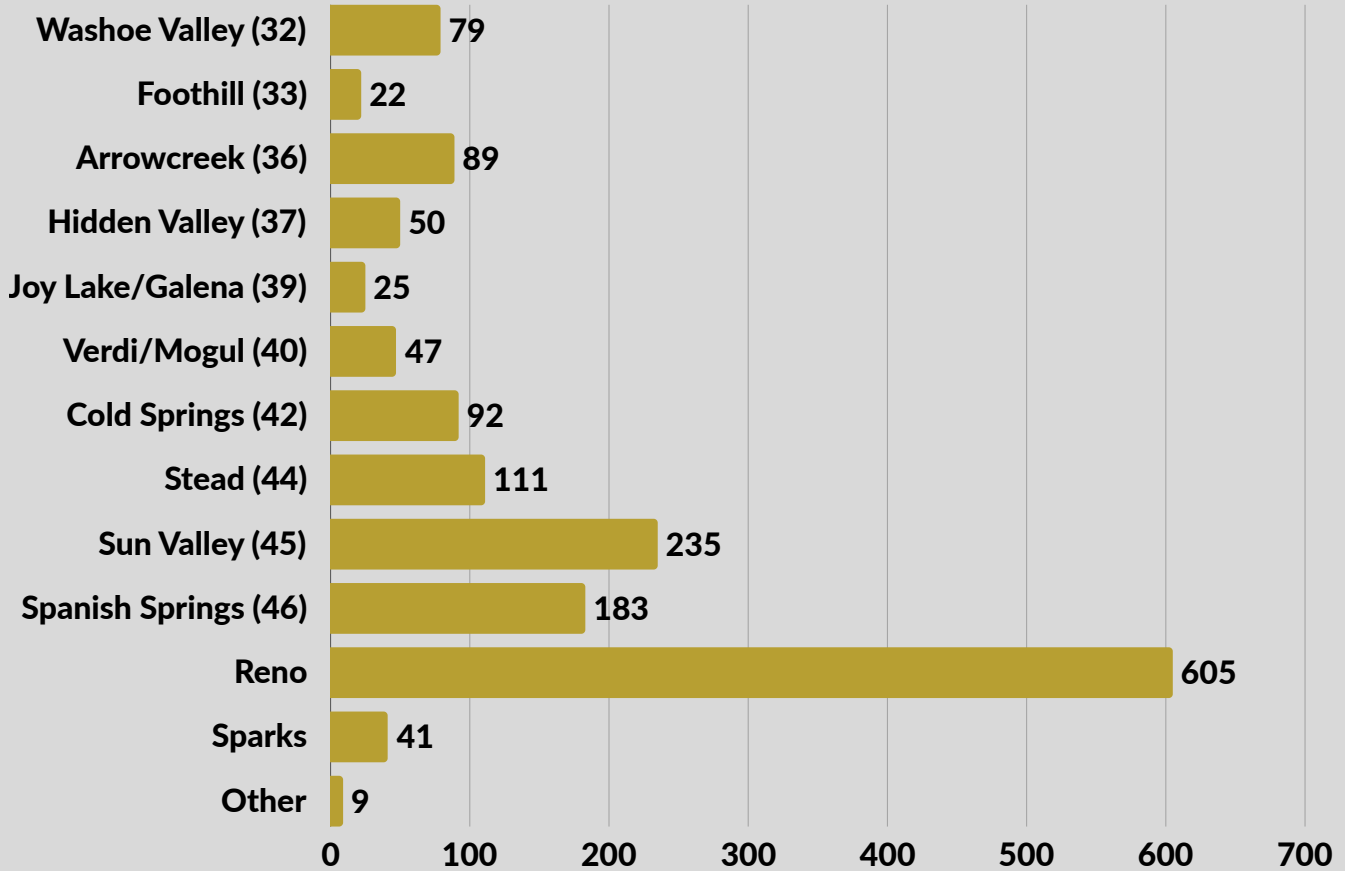
- **Citizens Assist:** Service call, lift assist, person in distress
- **Good Intent:** Controlled burning, investigate/nothing found, no incident upon arrival, smoke scare
- **False Alarm:** Accidental alarm, intentional false alarm, malfunctioning alarm, other false alarm
- **Alarms Non-Medical:** CO alarms, fire/smoke alarm, other alarms

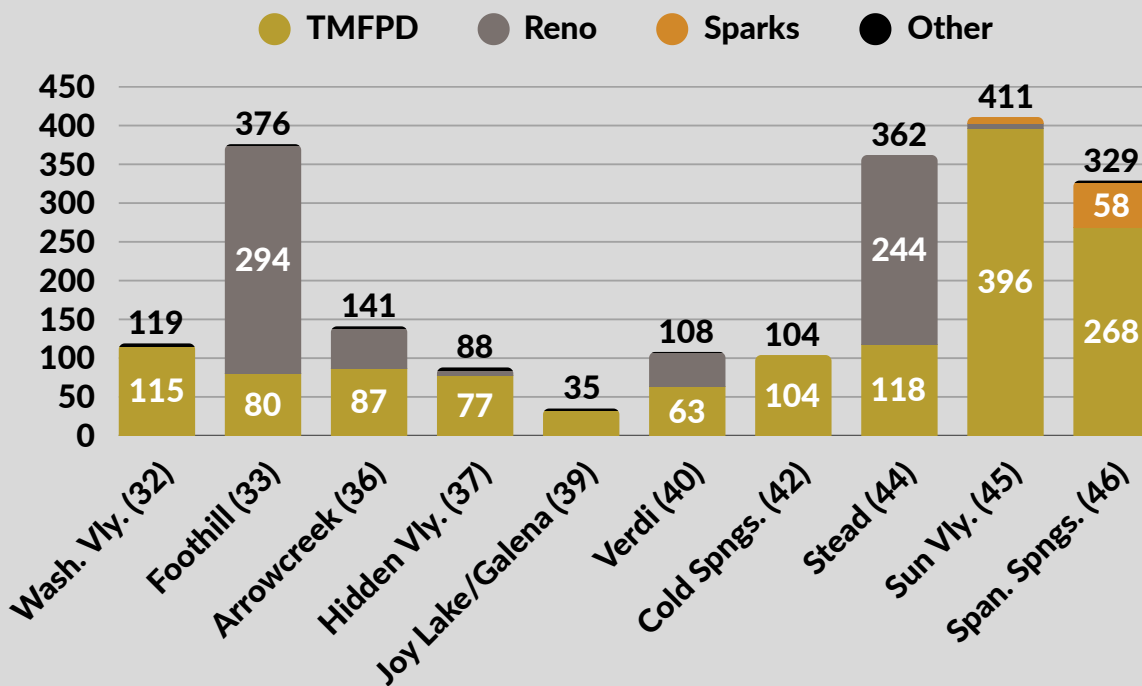

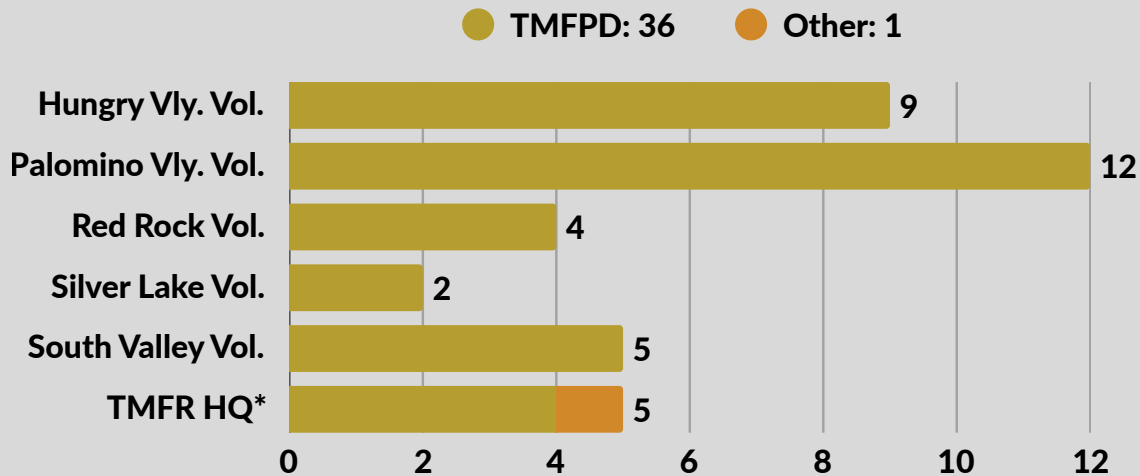
TM Unit Responses

TM Unit Responses by Jurisdiction - Volunteer & HQ: 37



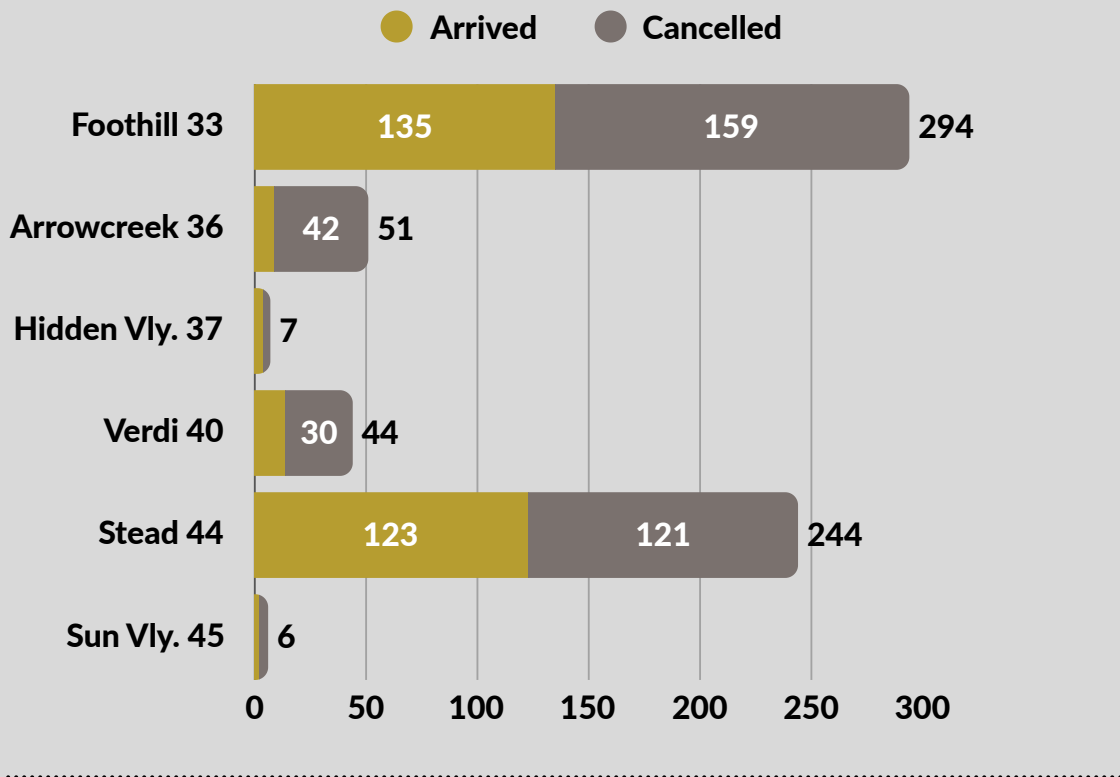

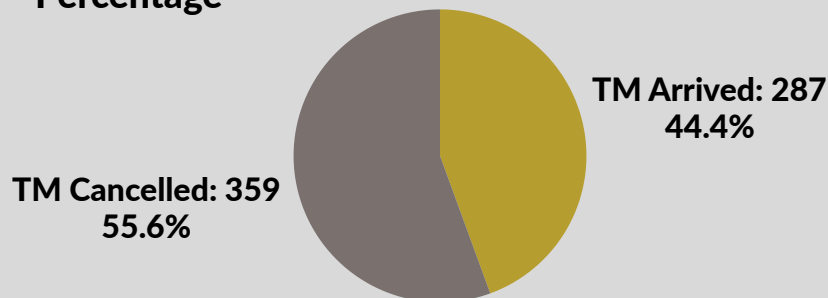

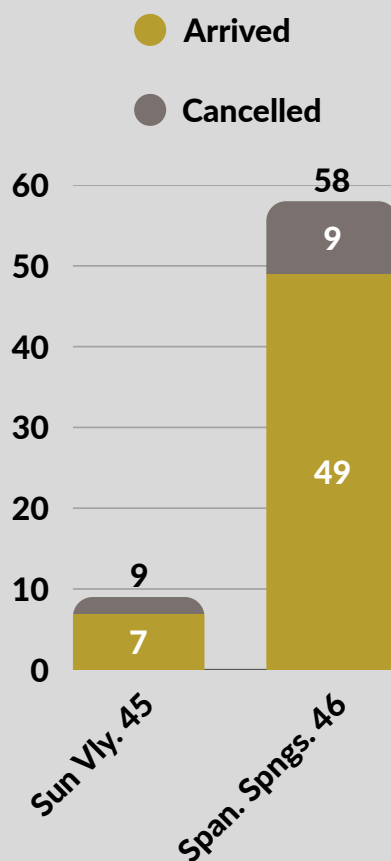

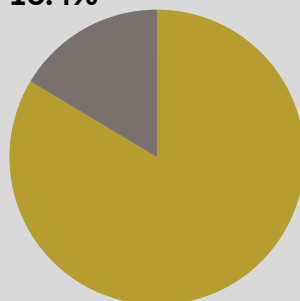
Mutual and Automatic Aid Provided - Career Stations

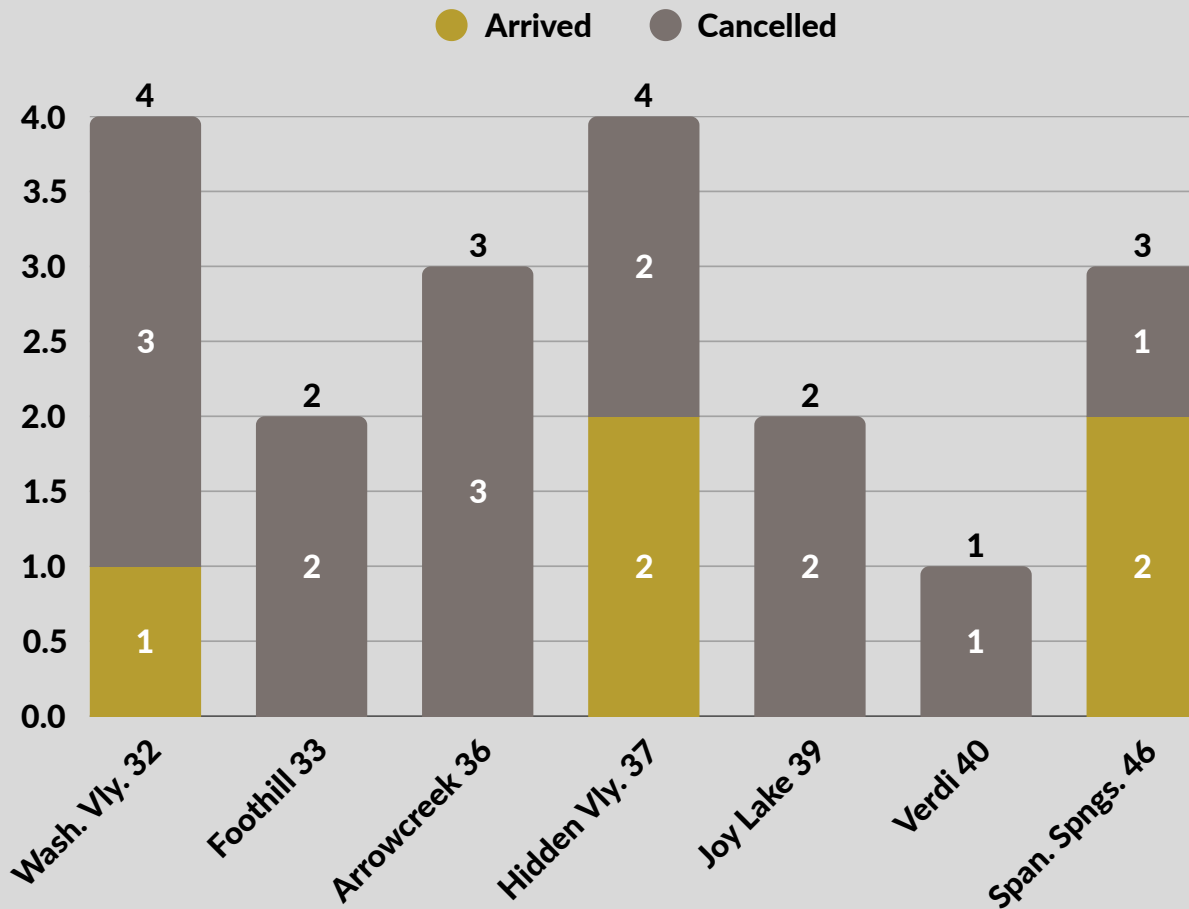

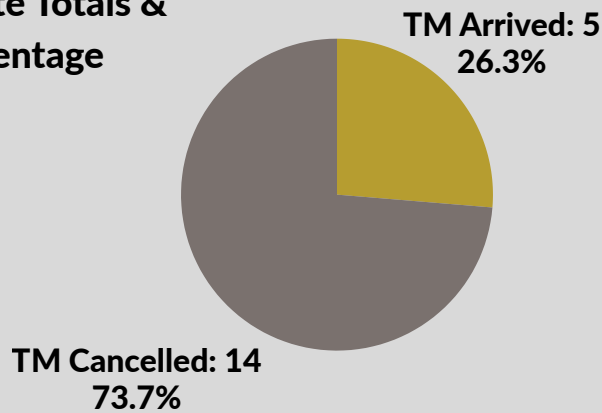


Mutual and Automatic Aid Provided - Career Stations

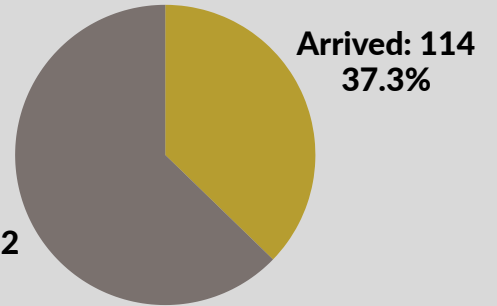
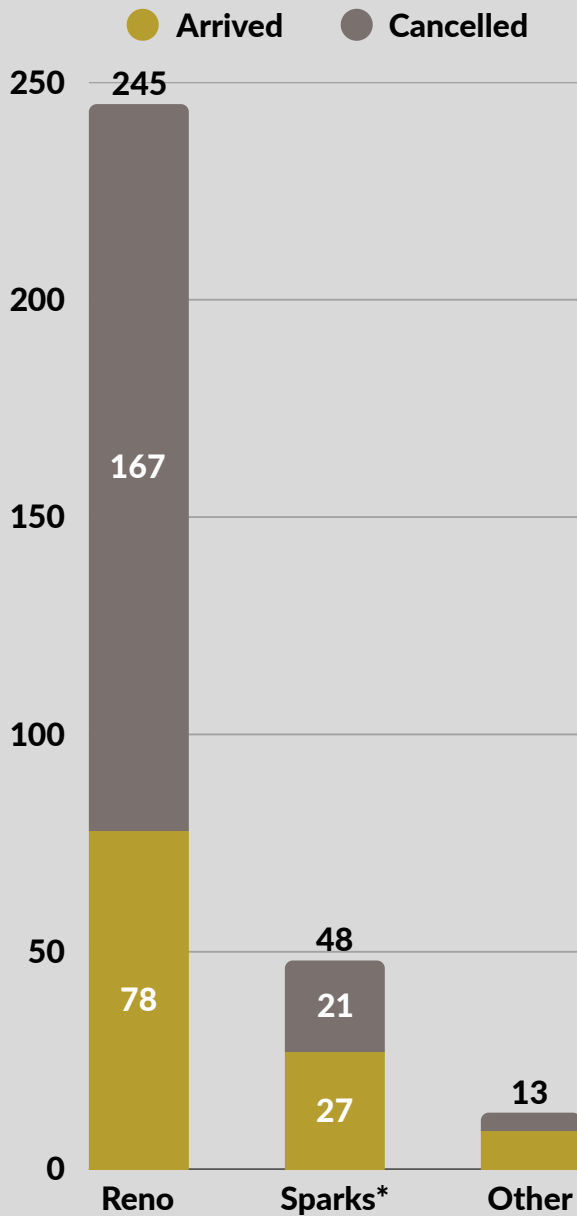




Mutual and Automatic Aid Received
