### Major Incident Summary

- 3/14:** TMFR Crews knocked down a structure fire at the 5400 block of Lupin Drive. An RV was also lost.  
**3/12-19:** Multiple prescribed burning operations along the Mt. Rose Corridor and Silver Lake area.  
**3/27:** A Union Pacific (UP) freight train encountered a derailment of 25-30 box cars near I-80 and USA Parkway inside the Washoe County line. No hazardous spills, fires, or injuries reported. UP is investigating.

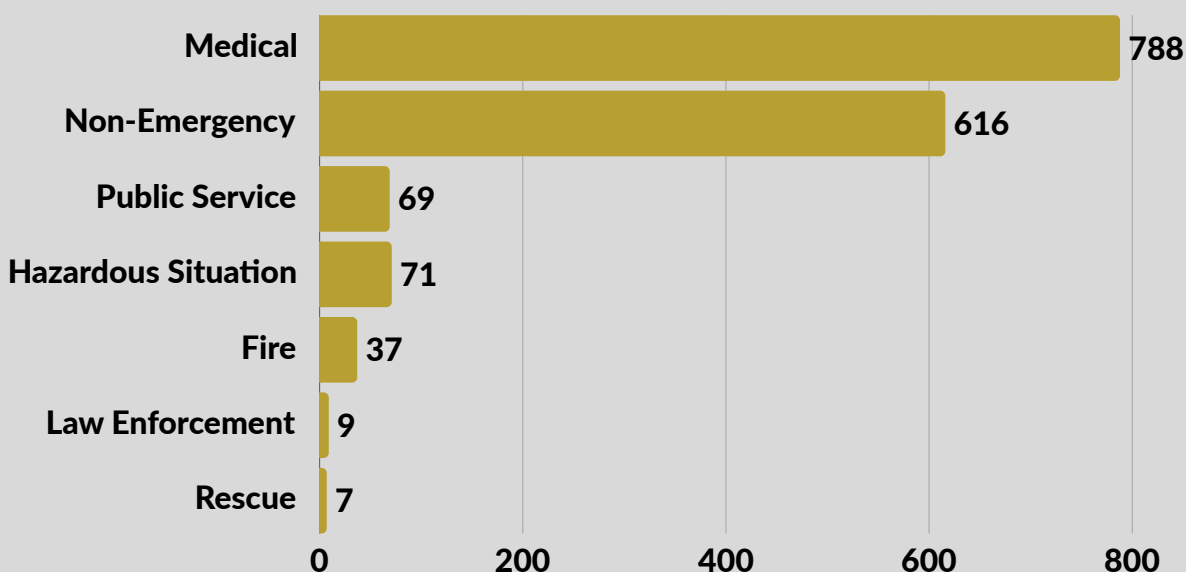
Trail Derailment on March 27, 2026



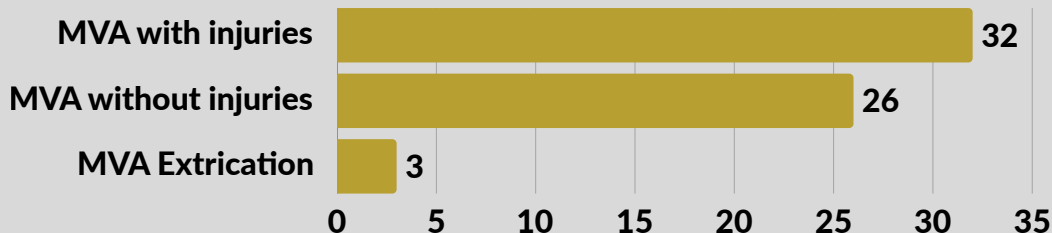
### Incident Statistics

Statistics and categories reflect the start of a new TMFPD and National reporting system that began January 1, 2026. TMFPD transitioned its reporting system to align with the National Emergency Response Information System (NERIS) to ensure uninterrupted national data reporting and compliance. NERIS replaced the 50-year old coding and manual data entry system known as NFIRS and expanded the capabilities to include all-hazard reporting with real-time data and improved interoperability.

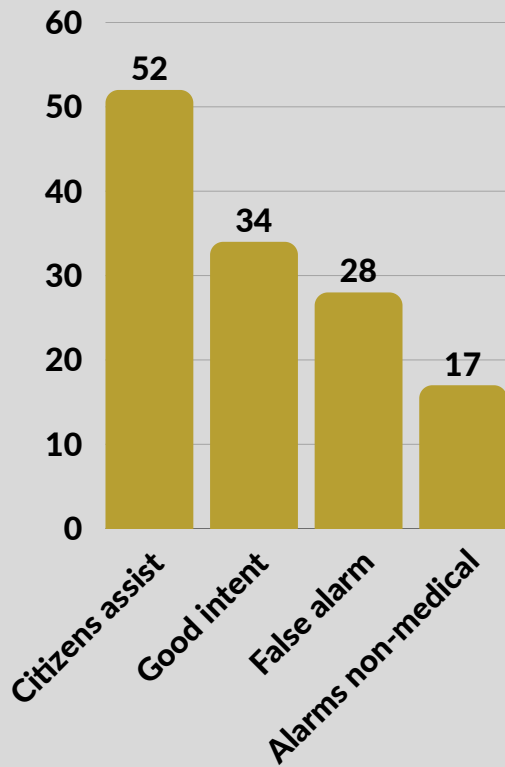


#### Motor Vehicle Accident (MVA) Detail, March 2026: 61





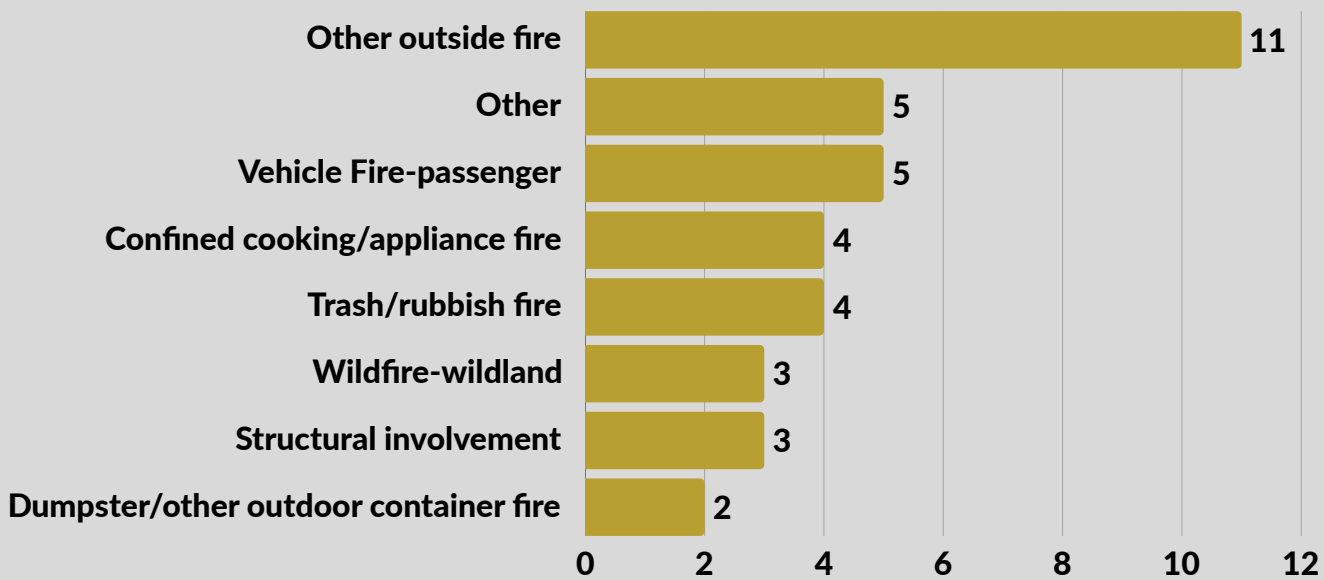

#### Call Types

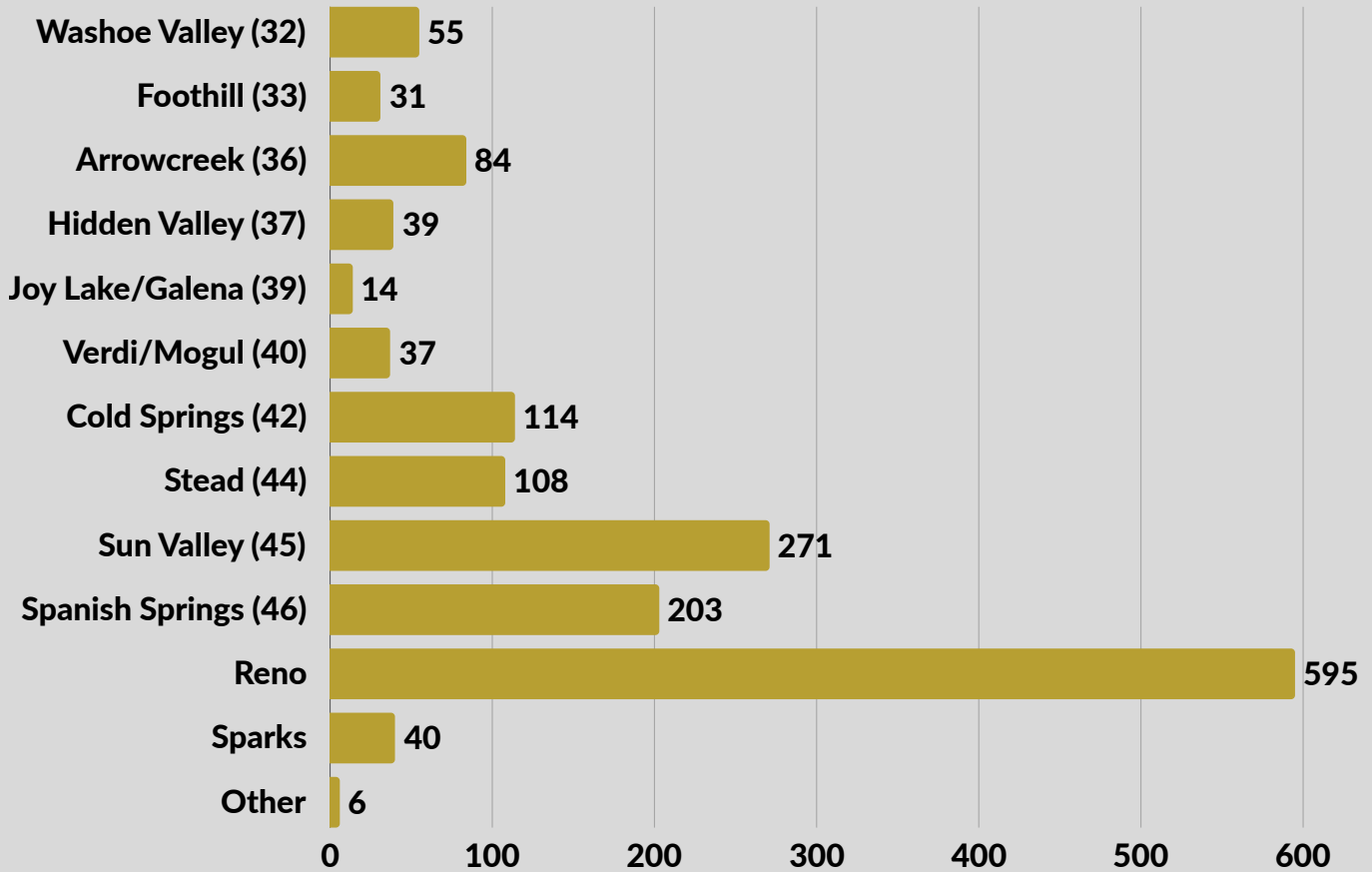
- **Citizens Assist:** Service call, lift assist, person in distress
- **Good Intent:** Controlled burning, investigate/nothing found, no incident upon arrival, smoke scare
- **False Alarm:** Accidental alarm, intentional false alarm, malfunctioning alarm, other false alarm
- **Alarms Non-Medical:** CO alarms, fire/smoke alarm, other alarms

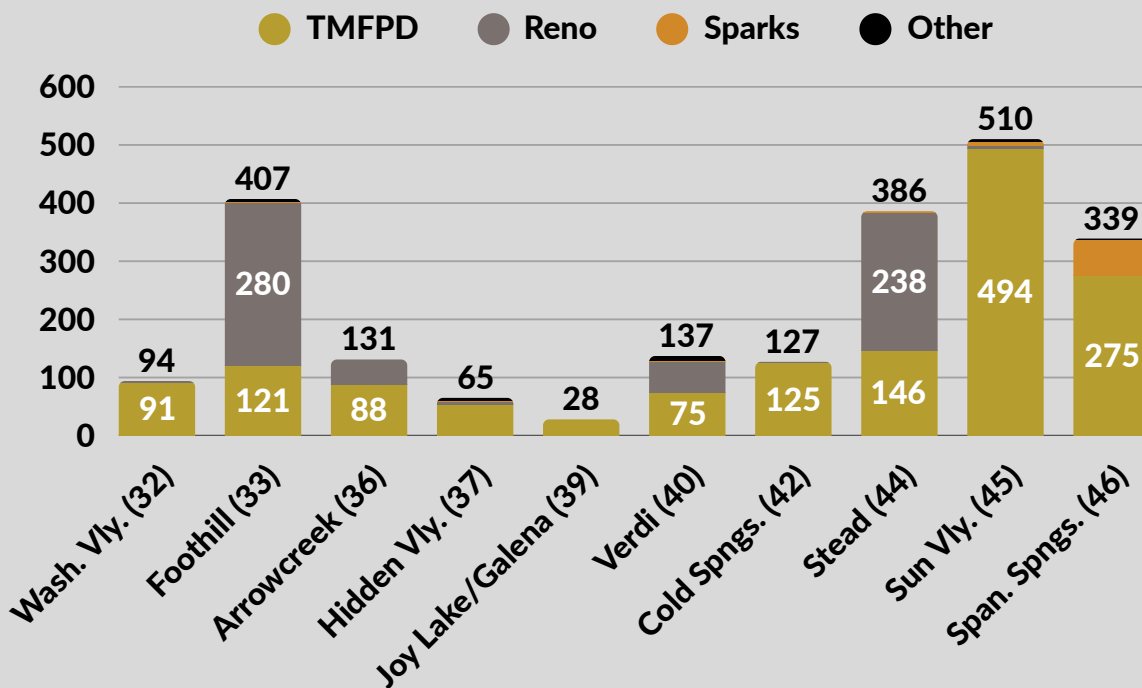


### TM Unit Responses

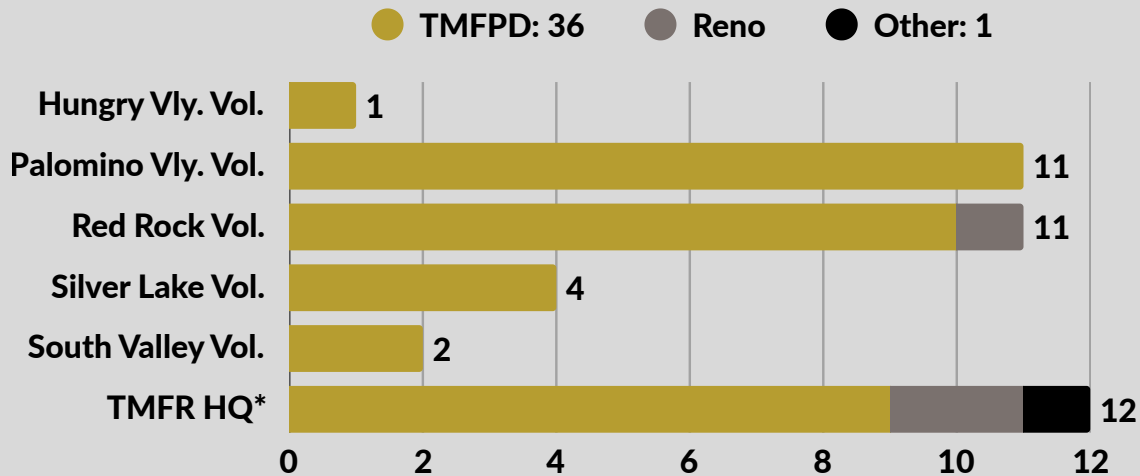
Some incidents require more than one resource to respond. The information below reflects the number of unit responses.

### TM Unit Responses by Jurisdiction - Volunteer & HQ: 40



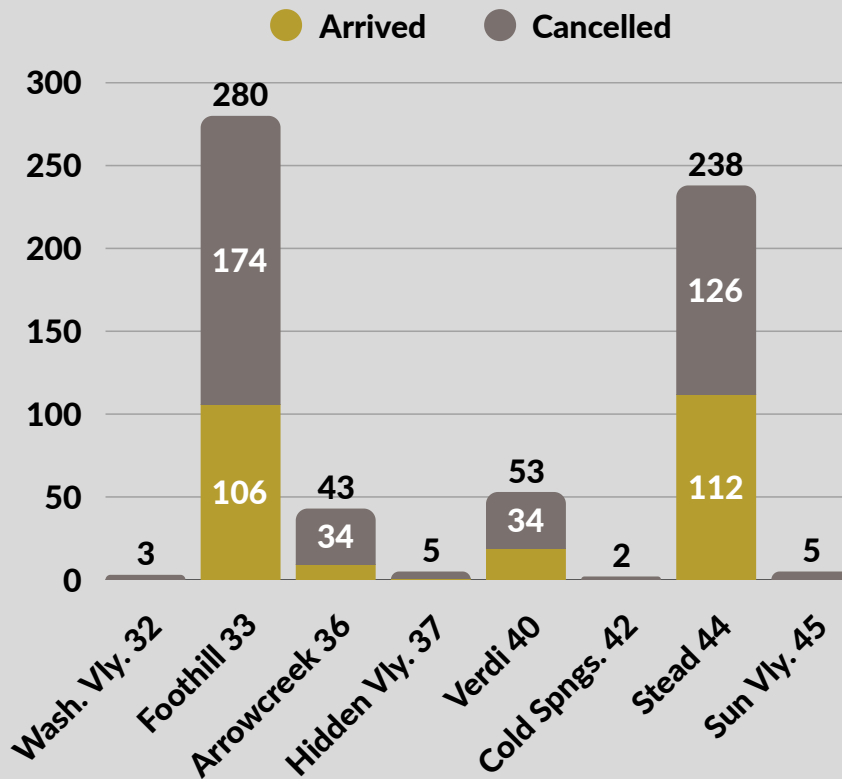

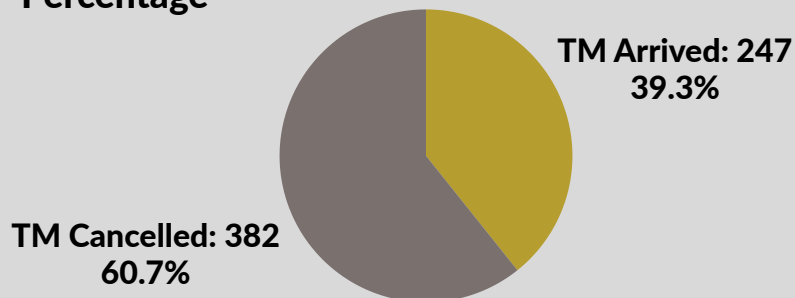

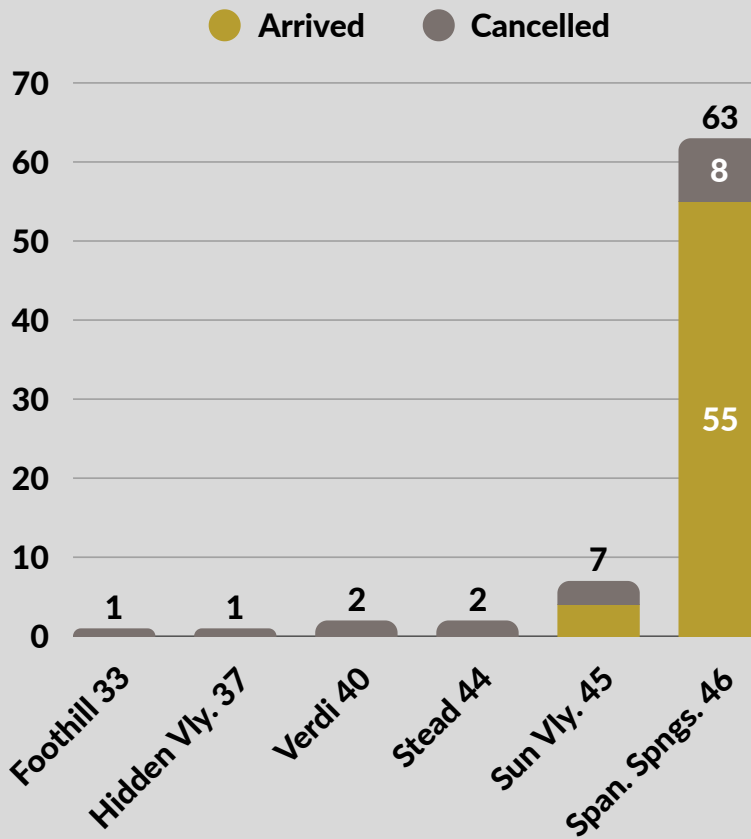
#### Aggregate Totals & Percentage





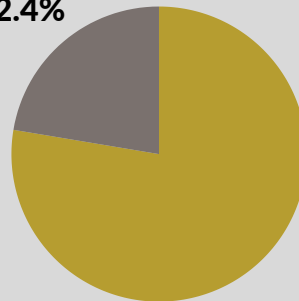

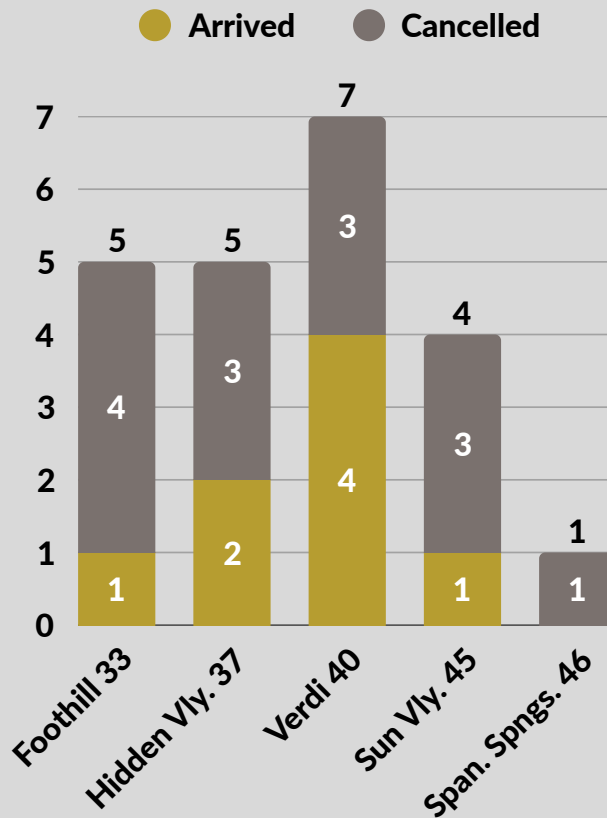

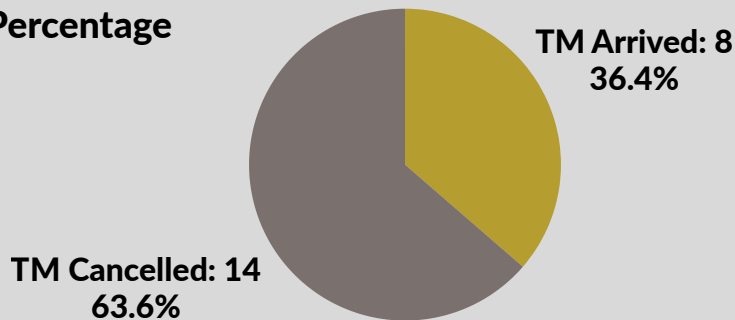

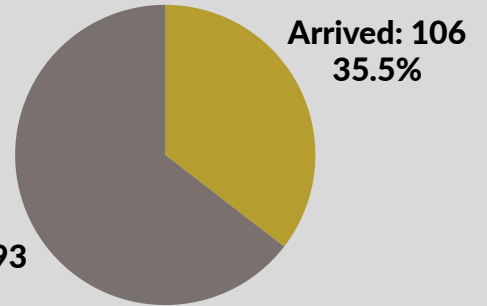
