SUMMARY

This item requests the Board to approve to commit funds in the amount of \$50,000.00 that were authorized by the Board at the December 16, 2025, meeting for the purpose of having an economic study plan conducted for the Sun Valley area.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Economic Impacts

PREVIOUS ACTION

December 16, 2025 – the Board approved the Commission District Special Fund in the amount of \$55,000 for fiscal year 2025-26; District 3 Commissioner Mariluz Garcia recommends a \$50,000 grant to Washoe County Office of the County Manager – a government entity – for the purpose of having an economic study plan conducted for the Sun Valley area; and a \$5,000 grant to Great Basin Community Food Co-op – a nonprofit organization created for charitable, religious, or educational purposes – to support the Co-ops Friends of the Foodshed to promote a healthy lifestyle for all living things.

BACKGROUND

The Board of County Commissioners at the December 16, 2025, meeting authorized the use of District 3 discretionary funds for the use of having an economic study plan for the Sun Valley area in the amount of \$50,000.00. Additional time is needed to complete this project, therefore it is being requested that these funds be committed for use to complete the project in fiscal year 2027.
