SUMMARY

This is for discussion and possible election of an Emergency Medical Services Advisory Committee (EMSAB) Chair as this position is due for election.

PREVIOUS ACTION

At the February 20, 2025, EMSAB meeting, Manager Brown was nominated for a second term, and elected as, the Chair of the Board.

At the August 23, 2023, EMSAB meeting, Manager Brown was nominated for, and elected as, the Chair of the Board.

At the August 4, 2022, EMSAB meeting, Mr. Neil Krutz was nominated for, and elected as, the Chair of the Board.

At the February 4, 2021, EMSAB meeting, Mr. Neil Krutz was nominated for, and elected as, the Chair of the Board.

BACKGROUND

The “Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board Bylaws,” effective May 2021, speaks to membership in Article II – Membership.

“Article II – Membership, Section 4 – Terms/Board Administration” states “The Advisory Board shall elect a chair and vice-chair from among its membership to manage the meetings. The chair and vice-chair shall service for one (1) year. Both positions are eligible for reappointment for up to one subsequent one (1) year term, limited to two consecutive terms.”

This specification makes Manager Brown eligible for nomination and re-election to the Chair position.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the Board discuss and possibly elect a new Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board Chair.
