Services:

Mental Health and Psychiatric care and med management – *available at no cost.*
Bilingual/bicultural therapists available.

Family Resource Center services – *system navigation, resource and referral, emergency financial aid, family crisis intervention, ESL classes, VITA, parent education programs*

Youth Programs – *programs designed to provide support to under-resourced youth that are struggling academically, social-emotionally, or due to mental health concerns or trauma.*



Reoccurring Housing Challenges:

- **Lack of affordable, available inventory** (average rent in I.V. - \$3500 per month, average wage - \$20.48 hr. or \$42,950 annually)
- **Rapid change to housing status** (sudden loss of roommate, sale of current unit by owner, switch unit from long-term to short-term vacation housing)
- **Transportation** (lack of public transportation options forces individuals to live and work near their employment. Often this is not possible, forcing families to move or leave the area.)

Techniques:

- Consistent mapping of available inventory
- Development of relationships with property owners and landlords
- Short-term financial assistance to stabilize a family while they build a plan, get a new job, etc.
- Honest and frank conversations with individuals about whether or not they can remain housed in the Tahoe basin, given the cost and shortage of available units. Assist with moves if necessary.
- Assistance in finding roommates to share costs
