

RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Michael Clark for District 2, has determined that \$5,000.00 will be granted to the Robert Unsworth Foundation, to support their mission to provide tennis equipment and instruction to public schools and youth groups; and

WHEREAS, the Robert Unsworth Foundation is a nonprofit organization that was created following the sudden passing of 22-year-old Reno tennis player and instructor of the same name, in order to give everyone an opportunity to experience the joys of tennis; and

WHEREAS, the foundation will work with local public schools, youth organizations, and area tennis professionals and enthusiasts to provide instruction and mentoring in tennis, and hopes to expand beyond tennis to golf and fencing; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to the Robert Unsworth Foundation, a grant for fiscal year 2023-2024 in the amount of \$5,000.00.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
4. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution's approval.
