

Our Vision

- We envision a community where every individual, no matter their past, has the opportunity for successful reentry after incarceration.
 - Jail-based, pre-release reentry programs
 - Provide the structure, tools, and support for change
 - What is successful reentry?
 - Reduce recidivism and increase long-term stability

The Challenge We Faced

- Funding structure
- Lack of institutional knowledge
- Outdated processes: "The way we've always done it..."
- Programming was often ineffective and misaligned
- No tools to measure outcomes or improvement


Commitment to change

- Launched June-July 2024 with full agency support:
 - Department-wide transformation
 - Evidence-based, data-driven, holistic
 - Built to work and built to prove it
 - Not platitudes

Screening Tool


- Partnered with national researchers
 - Existing tools didn't meet our needs so we built one
 - 550 + participants
 - ±4% margin of error
 - 95% confidence level
 - Comprehensive research report
 - Partnering with research agency to create a predictive model

Screening Tool Results



88% did not have gainful employment

Screening Tool Results



74% did not have stable or independent housing

Updated Programming

- Capacity mapping
- Assessed all existing programming for impact
- Phased out ineffective legacy programming
- Invested in what works:
 - TMCC Adult Basic Ed
 - UNR CFRC Home Visiting parent-child connection
 - Remote CBT
 - In-House Chaplain Travis Sharpe

Community Collaboration

- Over 80 partners across local, state, and national levels
- Sectors: education, workforce, clinical, justice
- Our strongest asset: collaboration
- Real partnerships → real results → real scalability
- Headwinds

What's Next (FY25/26)

- Validate and refine predictive screening tool
- Scale what works: TMCC, UNR Home Visiting, Remote
- Provide state-level subject matter expertise
 - How does your program define successful reentry?
 - It isn't meaningful if it isn't measurable
- Long-Term: WCSO Community Reentry Center
