**SUMMARY**

This item is a recommendation to approve an Interlocal Agreement between the State of Nevada Division of Public & Behavioral Health (Public Health Preparedness Program) and Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District for the storage and maintenance of CHEMPACK containers to include deployment when necessary.

**PREVIOUS ACTION**

**BACKGROUND**

Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District serves as a critical repository for the Nevada CHEMPACK program, a state-managed, federally-funded initiative designed to provide rapid access to chemical nerve agent antidotes. By strategically pre-positioning these specialized medical caches at a TMFPD facility, the district ensures that life-saving medications such as atropine and pralidoxime are immediately available to first responders and the public in the event of a large-scale chemical release or organophosphate poisoning. This partnership with the Nevada Public Health Preparedness Program response framework allows TMFPD paramedics to bridge the gap during the "platinum hour" of a crisis.

The proposed Interlocal Agreement allows TMFPD to act as a CHEMPACK Storage Facility; outlines requirements for the storage, maintenance, security and use of CHEMPACK containers

and their contents; and sets forth expectations regarding TMFPD's responsibility to facilitate access to Division of Public & Behavioral Health personnel and federal Strategic National Stockpile personnel for inventory, security and quality assurance checks.

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board approve an Interlocal Agreement between the State of Nevada Division of Public & Behavioral Health (Public Health Preparedness Program) and Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District for the storage, maintenance, security and use of CHEMPACK containers, to include deployment when necessary.
