## **SUMMARY**

Senior Services receives numerous generous donations throughout the year that assist in providing services. Donations supplement the Agency's grants and contracts that serve Washoe County's growing senior population and are brought to the Board for acceptance.

#### **PREVIOUS ACTION**

The Board approves donations received by the Human Services Agency on a regular basis.

### **BACKGROUND**

The Agency is requesting retroactive approval of the following donations that have been received by Senior Services for the time period December 20, 2021 through March 25, 2022 and will need to be retroactively accepted in order to have the budget amended:

Anonymous \$696.03 Finley Estate \$5,000.00

The following donated items have been received for the time period December 20, 2021 through March 25, 2022 and will need to be retroactively accepted:

- Calendar, Blanket, Hats, Socks, Gloves, Slippers, and Scarfs received by Human Services Agency Senior Services from Eden Home Health - estimated market value of \$50.00.
- Smith's Groceries Gift Cards (7) in the amount of \$25 each received by Human Services Agency Senior Services from Eden Home Health estimated market value of \$175.00.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

Should the Board accept these donations, the Human Services Agency – Senior Services Fund (225) FY22 adopted budget will need to be amended by \$5,588.03 in the following revenue and expenditure accounts. The budget is not being amended in the total amount of the donation to account for an overage in authority in the amount of \$108.00. The amendment of \$5,588.03 will bring the budget authority into alignment for FY22.
