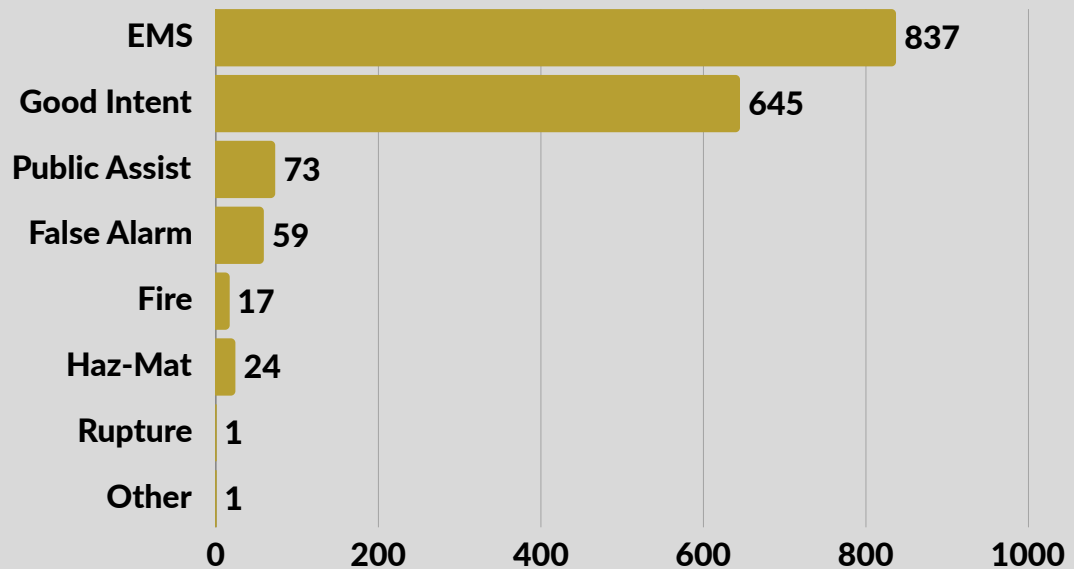




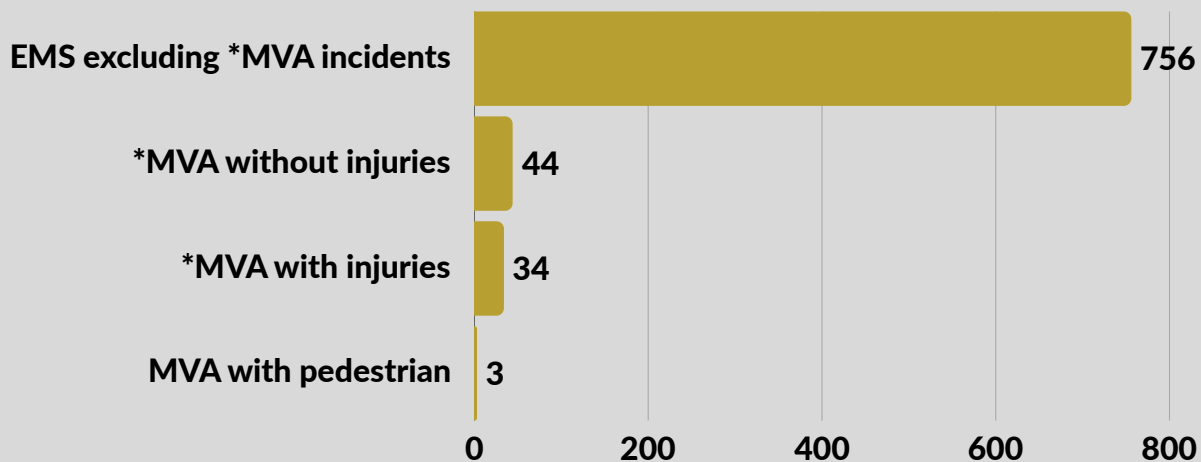

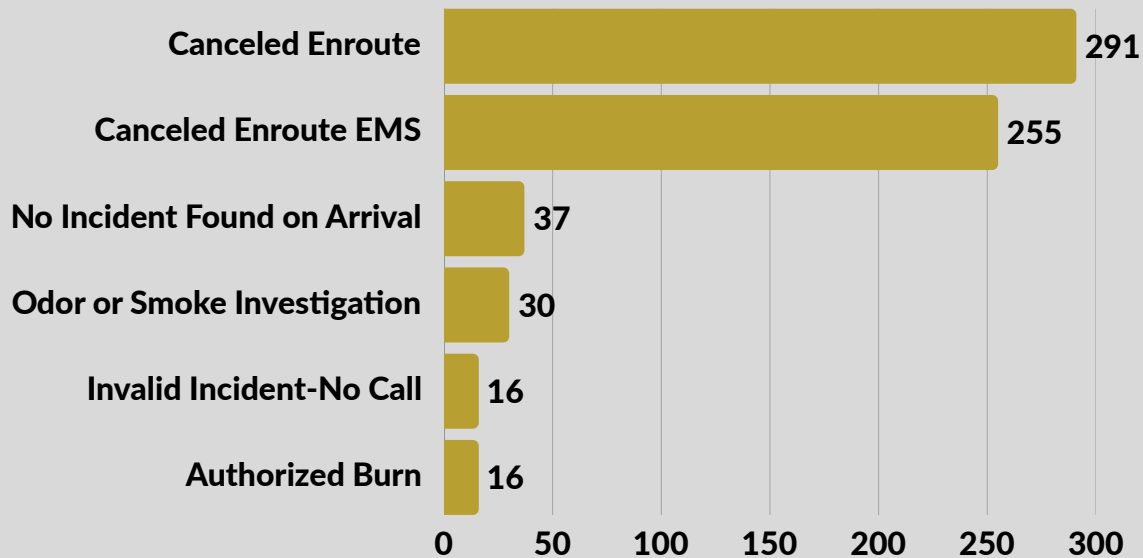

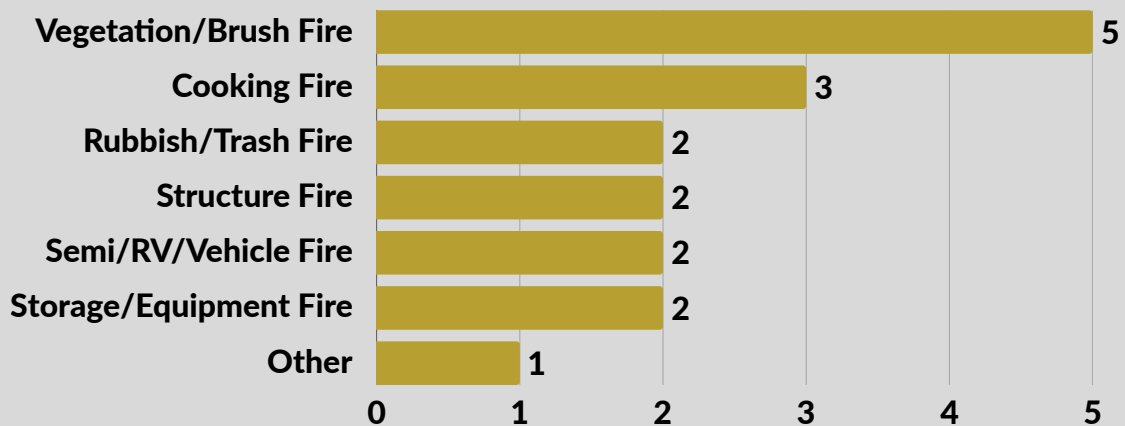

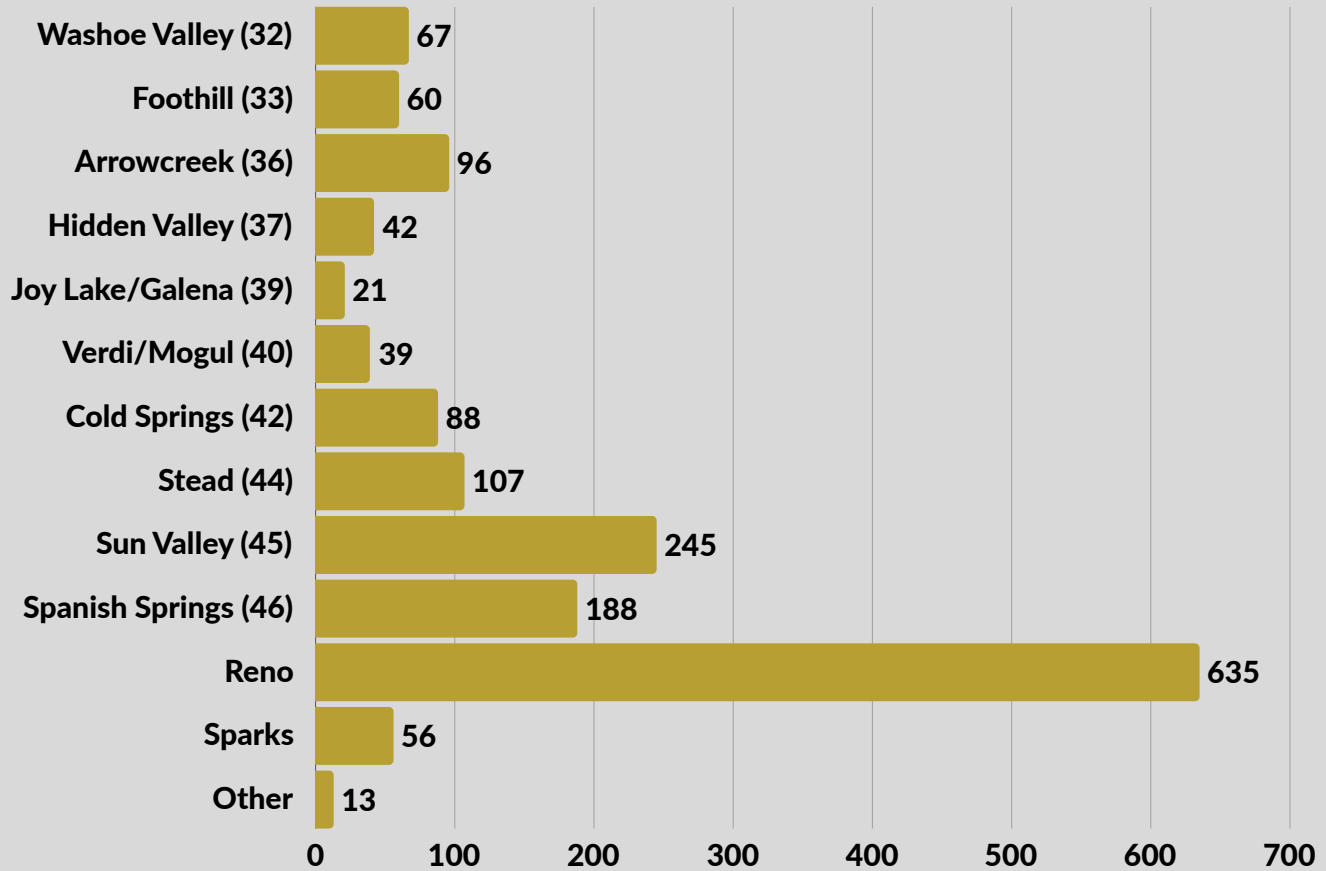

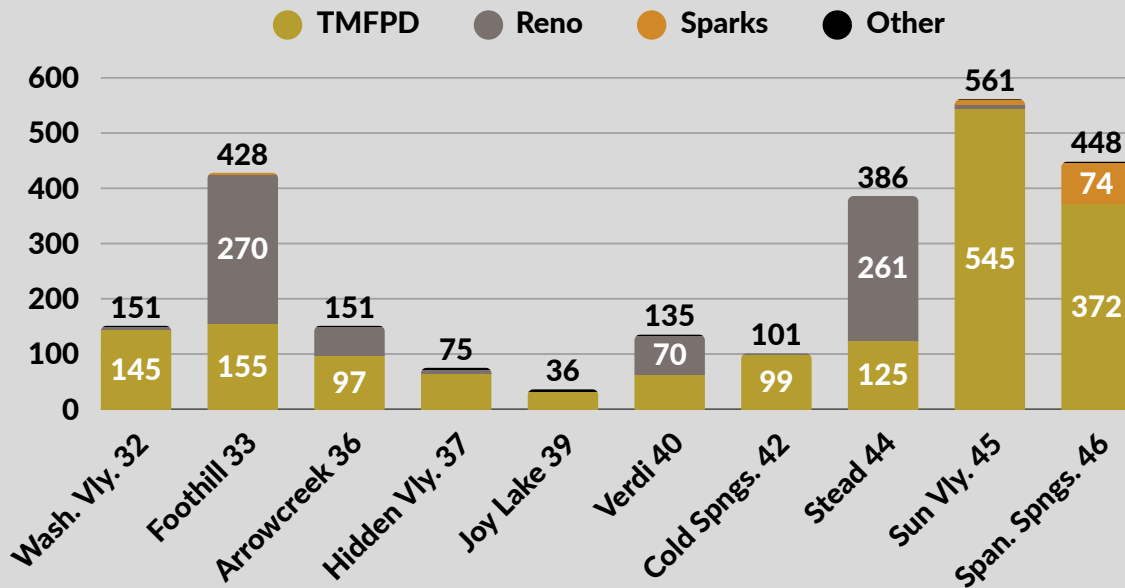

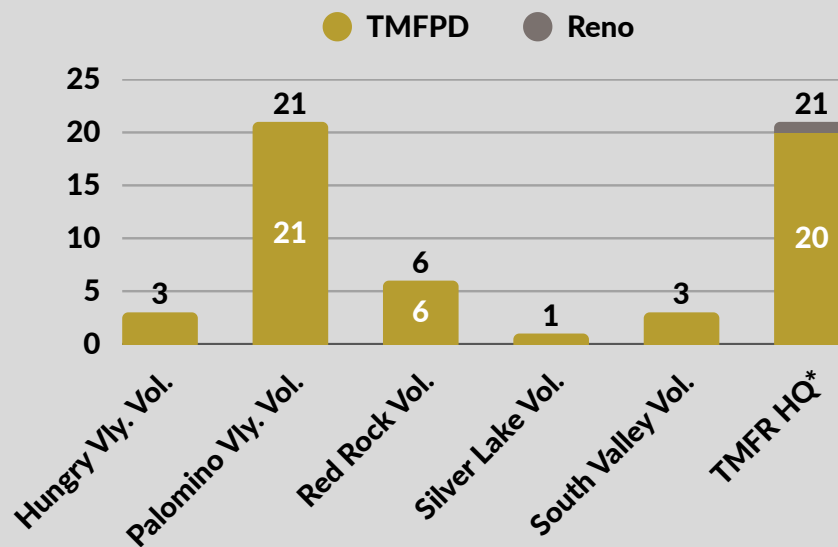
November TM Unit Responses

TM Unit Responses by Jurisdiction - Volunteer & HQ: 55



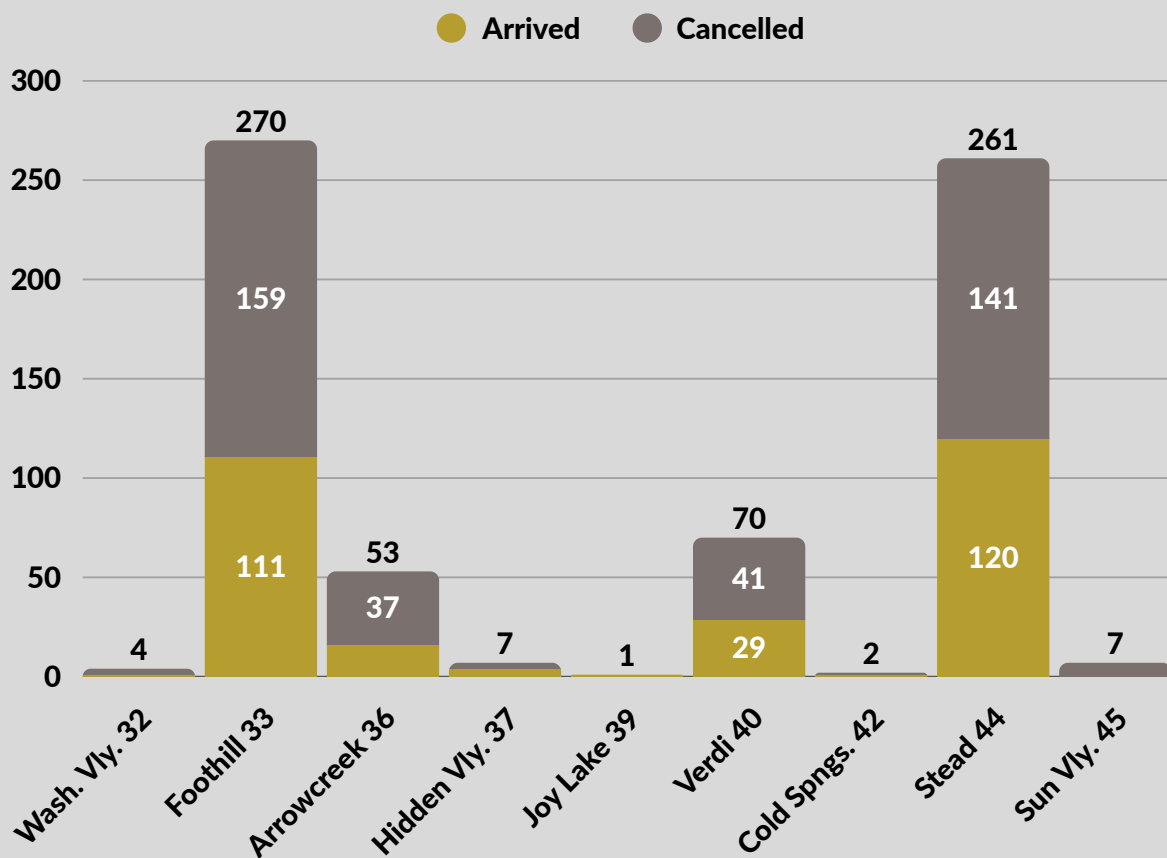

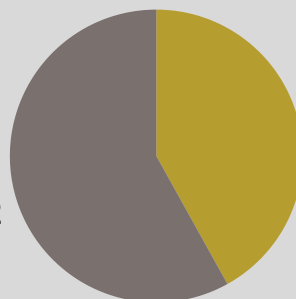

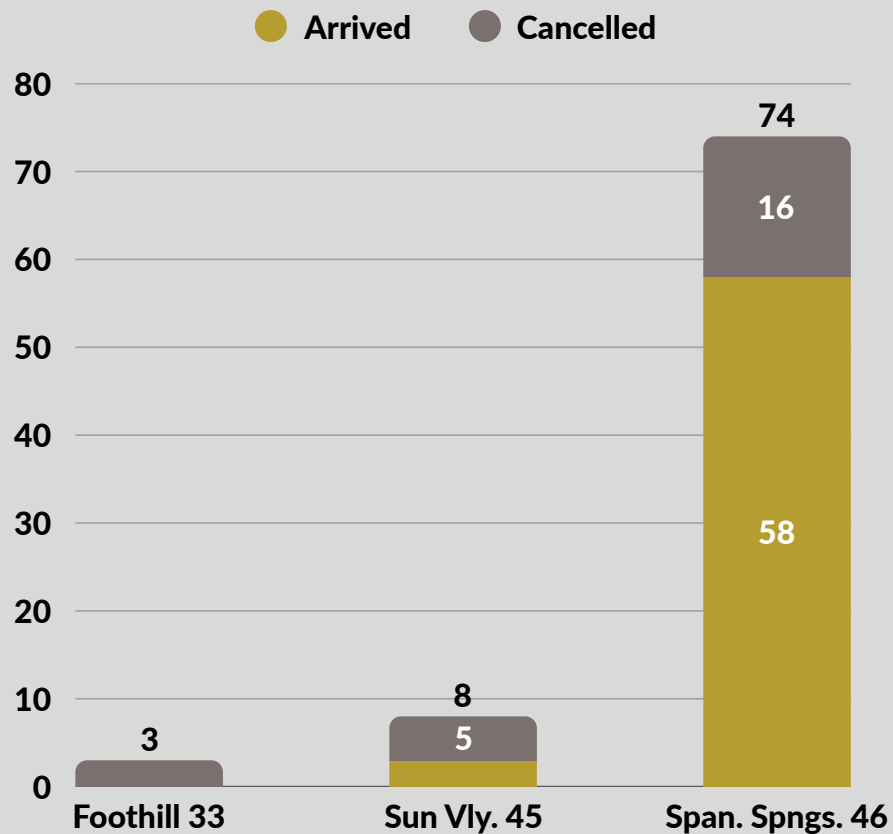

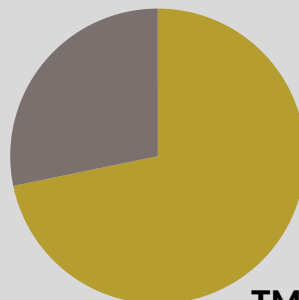
November 2025 Mutual and Automatic Aid Provided - Career Stations

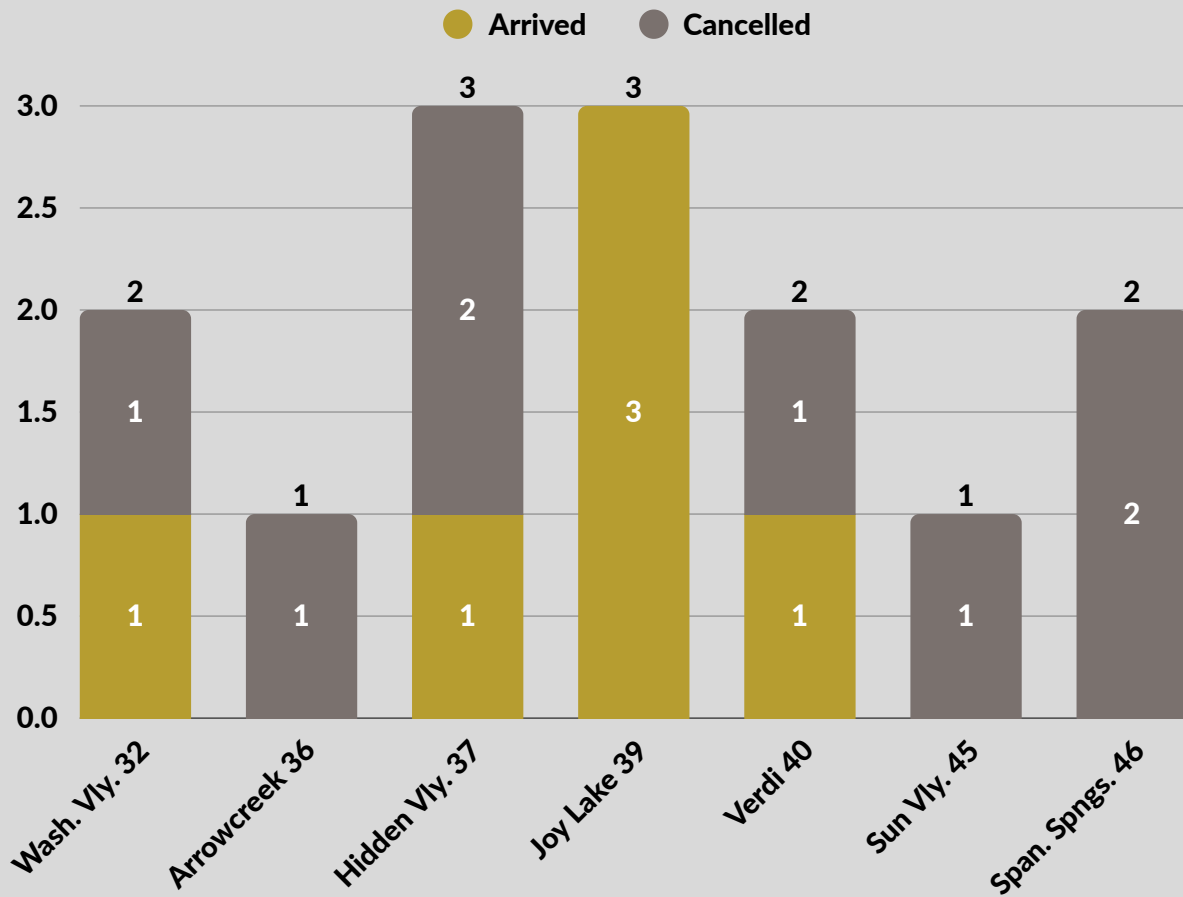

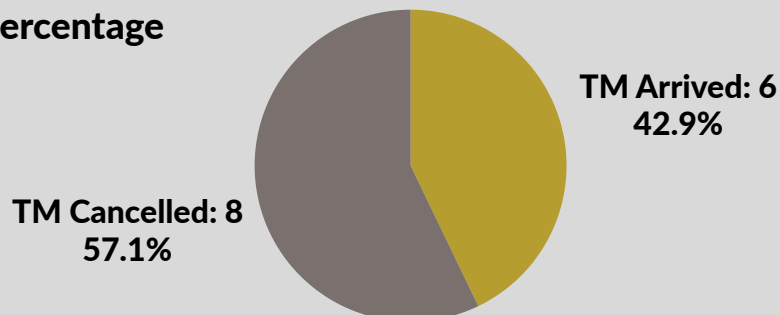

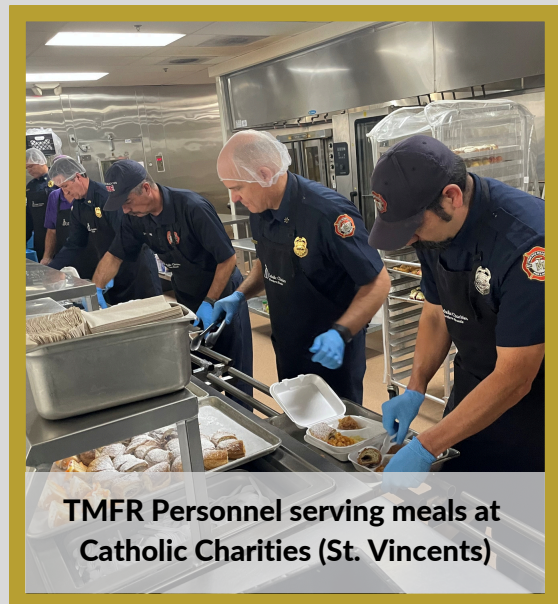
