SUMMARY

PREVIOUS ACTION

BACKGROUND

Northern Nevada Public Health (NNPH) recognized the need for an assessment of the Environmental Health Division and its business practices. The EHS division enlisted Just Evaluation Services (JESS) to conduct an organization assessment. The assessment aimed at evaluating the following questions:

- How does NNPH EHS compare to other EHS divisions serving a similar community profile?
- How do key stakeholders (e.g., regulated public, government partners) perceive NNPH EHS?

The assessment was designed to provide a benchmark for the EHS division using a comparative analysis to other health departments as well as soliciting stakeholder feedback and observing field staff conducting inspections to identify areas for improvement and opportunities to enhance EHS's efficiency, effectiveness, and service delivery. The project developed actionable recommendations to help EHS improve delivery of services to the public and compiled their findings into the attached report.
