

RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Alexis Hill for District 1, has determined that \$2,800 will be granted to RennerVation Foundation, a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- to sponsor two campers at Camp RennerVation 2026; and

WHEREAS, RennerVation Foundation was created to serve youth in foster care and underserved youth through meaningful, hands-on programs; and

WHEREAS, RennerVation Foundation believes that every young person deserves the chance to feel seen, supported and empowered; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to RennerVation Foundation a grant for fiscal year 2026-2027 in the amount of \$2,800.00.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
4. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution's approval.
