<u>RESOLUTION</u> – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that the Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, upon the recommendation of Commissioner Mariluz Garcia for District 3, has determined that \$5,000.00 will be granted to Great Basin Community Food Co-op to support the Friends of the Foodshed to promote a healthy lifestyle for all living things; and

WHEREAS, Great Basin Community Food Co-op began when a few people got together to create a business that would meet a mutual need to increase community access to affordable, sustainable, local, and wholesome food that enriches the health of Northern Nevada's environment and economy; and

WHEREAS, Friends of the Foodshed is a non-profit that has been preserving the work of farmers and ranchers in Northern Nevada and connected watersheds for over 20 years; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

- 1. The Board hereby grants Great Basin Community Food Co-op a grant for fiscal year 2025-2026 in the amount of \$5,000.00.
- 2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County by meeting the needs of our growing community, supporting a thriving community, and strengthening our culture of service.
- 3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.

4. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution's approval.
