EMS OPERATIONS UPDATES

During the second quarter of 2026, the Reno Fire Department recognized both firefighters as well as UNR police and six community members, for saving a cardiac arrest patient. Coincidentally the event happened during CPR & AED awareness week which made it that much more special. Additionally the following events occurred:

-The EMS division continued to ensure all frontline employees maintain training and certification in basic life support (BLS), adult and pediatric advanced life support, and prehospital trauma care.

-Reno Fire Department hosted continuing education classes including respiratory therapy, in-flight emergencies, and LVAD management. These courses were offered free to providers within the department as well as our regional partners.

Provided BLS CPR and first aid training to educators and support staff at a preschool, all law enforcement academy cadets, and all newly hired emergency dispatchers.

-Provided training and familiarization on mechanical CPR devices to local area hospital staff. This will help to ensure seamless integration and transfer of care for patients brought in on these devices.

-After adding 2 weeks of curriculum, EMS training cadre from RFD and TMFR certified 42 NNLEA cadets in Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (TECC) for Law Enforcement Officers (LEO). Cadre further facilitated training in Rescue Task Force integration and incident management, which concluded with a culmination exercise involving regional police, fire, and EMS partners.
