SUMMARY

PREVIOUS ACTION

For the past 42 consecutive years, Washoe County has been a recipient of this prestigious award and the Board of County Commissioners has acknowledged receipt of the recognition of the achievement.

BACKGROUND

The Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting has been awarded to Washoe County by the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA) for the annual comprehensive financial report (ACFR) for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2024. The Certificate of Achievement is the highest form of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting, and its attainment represents a significant accomplishment by a government and its management.

The ACFR has been judged by an impartial panel to meet the high standards of the program, including demonstrating a constructive “spirit of full disclosure” to clearly communicate the County’s financial story.
