Major Incident Summary

January was focused on structure fire training through an acquired structure in Spanish Springs.

1/5: TMFR Crews knocked down a travel trailer fire in Sun Valley.

1/15: Crews attacked a pallet fire in Sun Valley.

1/24: TMFR Firefighters knocked down a fire involving two U-Haul trucks that were fully involved upon arrival. A third truck was damaged due to exposure. No loss of structures.







Incident Statistics

Statistics and categories reflect the start of a new TMFPD and National reporting system that began January 1, 2026. TMFPD transitioned its reporting system to align with the National Emergency Response Information System (NERIS) to ensure uninterrupted national data reporting and compliance. NERIS replaced the 50-year old coding and manual data entry system known as NFIRS and expanded the capabilities to include all-hazard reporting with real-time data and improved interoperability.




Motor Vehicle Accident (MVA) Detail: 83







Non-Emergency Public Service Calls


- **Alarms Non-Medical:** CO alarms, fire/smoke alarm, other alarms
- **Citizens Assist:** Service call, lift assist, person in distress
- **False Alarm:** Accidental alarm, intentional false alarm, malfunctioning alarm, other false alarm
- **Good Intent:** Controlled burning, investigate/nothing found, no incident upon arrival, smoke scare
- **Public Service Other:** Standby

Other Outside TM: City of Reno, City of Sparks, Gerlach, Headquarters, and outside of Washoe County.




TM Unit Responses


Some incidents require more than one resource to respond. The information below reflects the number of unit responses.

TM Unit Responses by Jurisdiction - Volunteer & HQ: 47










Mutual and Automatic Aid Provided - Career Stations






Mutual and Automatic Aid Provided - Career Stations







