SUBJECT: Recommendation to approve, pursuant to NRS 244.1505, Commission District Special Fund disbursement in the amount of [\$2,800.00] for Fiscal Year 2026-2027; District 1 Commissioner Alexis Hill recommends a [\$2,800.00] grant to RennerVation Foundation -- a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- to sponsor two campers at Camp RennerVation 2026 -- approve Resolution necessary for same; and direct Finance to make the necessary disbursement of funds. SUMMARY

This item requests the Board to approve Resolution and disburse district funds in the total amount of [\$2,800.00] for Commission District 1.

PREVIOUS ACTION

No previous action in Fiscal Year 2026-2027.

BACKGROUND

Modification of guidelines and adoption of resolution for County Commission District Special Funding on February 10, 2015, created Commission District Special Funds for each Commission District. On May 19, 2026, the Board of County Commissioners approved the 2026-2027 fiscal year budget with special district funds allocated per Commission District in the amount of \$100,000.00. The monies appropriated are to support needs for all Washoe County residents.

AGENDA ITEM # _____

Funds appropriated through the Commission District Special Funds must provide substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County. The recipient must be a non-profit organization, created for religious, charitable, or educational purposes, or a government entity. Funds shall not provide any personal or private benefit for the Commissioners, directly or indirectly benefit any campaign efforts by a commissioner, violate Ethics in Government law, or be used to purchase tickets to special events.

Commissioner Hill has elected to support the following organization in fiscal year 2026-2027:

- A [\$2,800.00] grant to RennerVation Foundation -- a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- to sponsor two campers at Camp RennerVation 2026.

FISCAL IMPACT

Sufficient FY26-27 budget authority exists within the Cost Center District 1 Constituents (C100101) and account Payments to other Agencies (710400). This action requests approval and distribution of a [total of \$2,800.00] to RennerVation Foundation.

Expense Disbursements are required as follows:

- RennerVation Foundation: \$2,800
