

**RESOLUTION** – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes

**WHEREAS**, NRS 244.1505 provides that the Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, upon the recommendation of Commissioner Mariluz Garcia for District 3, has determined that \$5,000.00 will be granted to Keep Truckee Meadows Beautiful (KTMB) for the purpose of supporting the organization’s continued community clean-up efforts, like the Great Community Cleanup and partnership with Washoe County for the Sun Valley drop off site; and

**WHEREAS**, KTMB is a nonprofit dedicated to creating a more sustainable and beautiful region through waste reduction, education and active community involvement; and

**WHEREAS**, KTMB serves a rich diversity of people and neighborhoods and is committed to treating individuals with respect and dignity; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants Keep Truckee Meadows Beautiful a grant for fiscal year 2023-2024 in the amount of \$5,000.00.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County by meeting the needs of our growing community, supporting a thriving community, and strengthening our culture of service.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
