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SUBJECT: Approve a Notice of Subaward from the State of Nevada Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public & Behavioral Health retroactive to March 1, 2026 through February 28, 2027 in the total amount of \$179,505.00 (no required match), in support of the Population Health Division (PHD) STD Prevention and Control Program, and authorize the District Health Officer to execute the Subaward and any future amendments.

SUMMARY

The Population Health Division received a Notice of Subaward from the State of Nevada Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public & Behavioral Health on March 12, 2026, to support the STD Prevention and Control Program. The funding period is March 1, 2026 through February 28, 2027. A copy of the Notice of Subaward is attached.

PREVIOUS ACTION

There has been no previous action taken by the Board this fiscal year.

BACKGROUND

The STD Prevention and Control Program conducts surveillance, reporting, and case identification for chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, congenital syphilis, and associated adverse health outcomes. Program activities include ongoing monitoring of the STD surveillance database; maintenance of case files and records; case investigations; preparation and submission of required reports; response planning for STD outbreaks; and promotion of quality STD specialty care services.

The Subaward provides funding for personnel and indirect expenditures.

This item is retroactive due to the Notice of Subaward being issued on March 12, 2026, and is being brought for approval at the nearest scheduled District Board of Health meeting.

FISCAL IMPACT

The District anticipated this award and included funding in the adopted FY26 budget. A budget adjustment will be made to move the authority to IO 12646.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the District Board of Health approve a Notice of Subaward from the State of Nevada Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public & Behavioral Health retroactive to March 1, 2026 through February 28, 2027 in the total amount of \$179,505.00 (no required match), in support of the Population Health Division (PHD) STD Prevention and Control Program, and authorize the District Health Officer to execute the Subaward and any future amendments.
