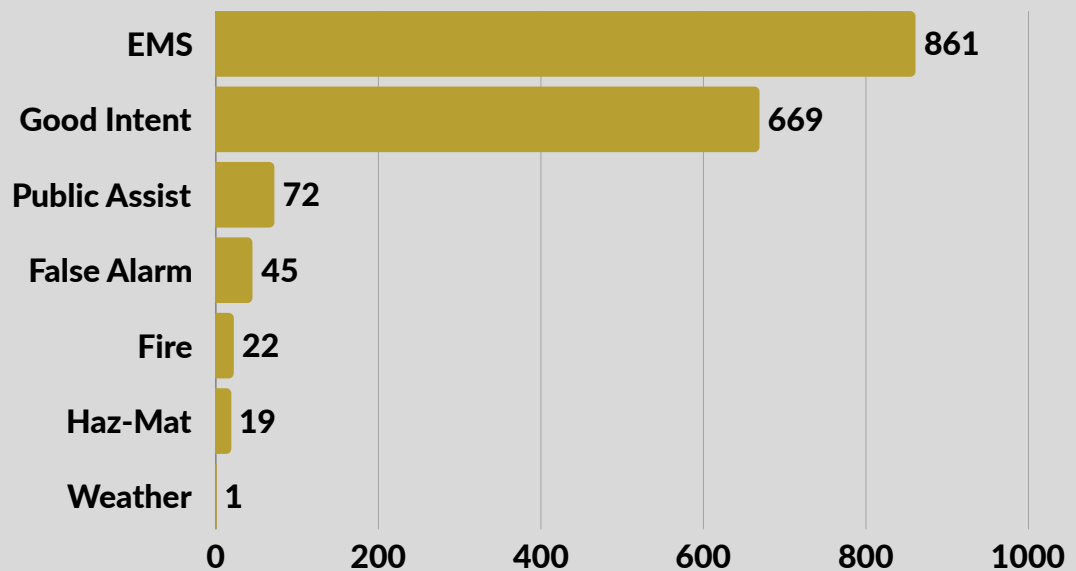

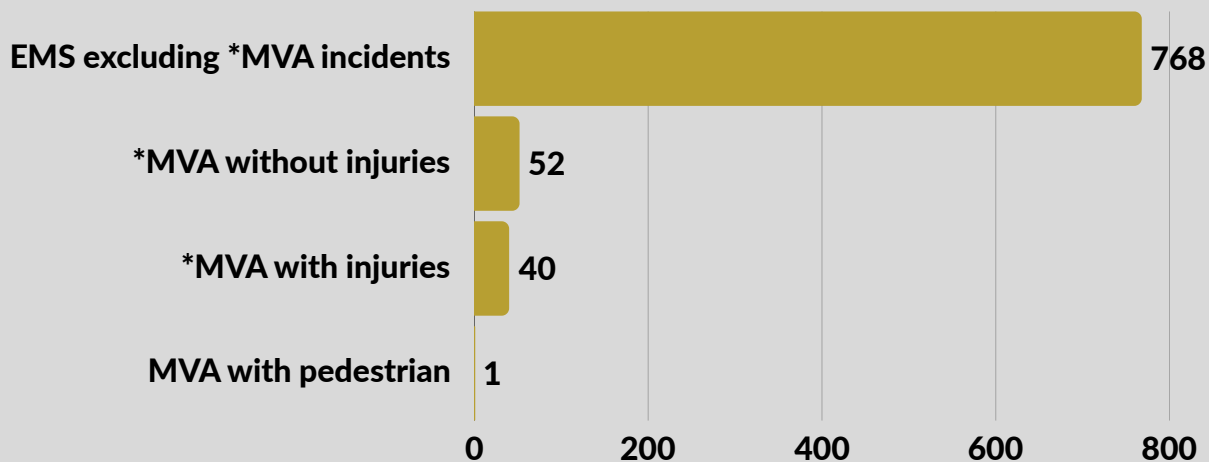

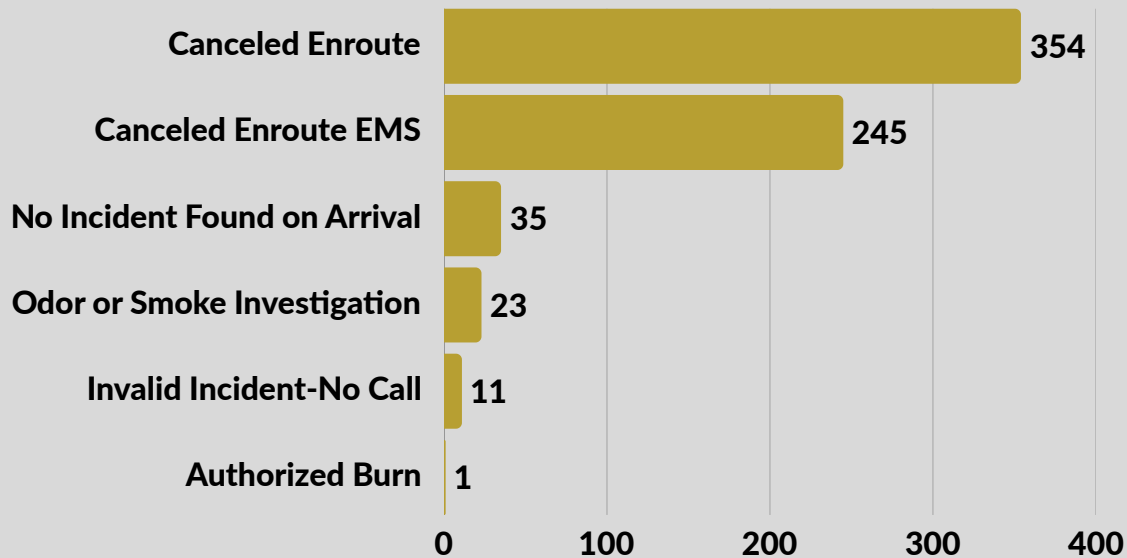

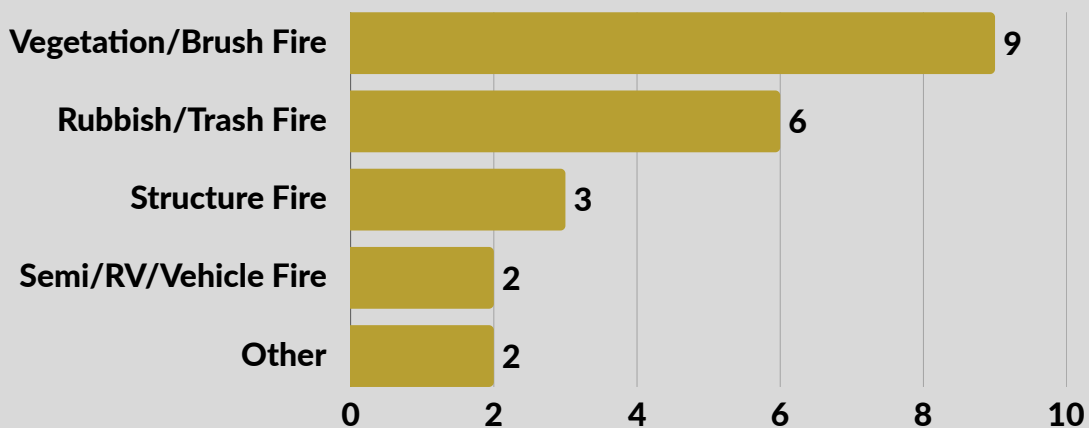

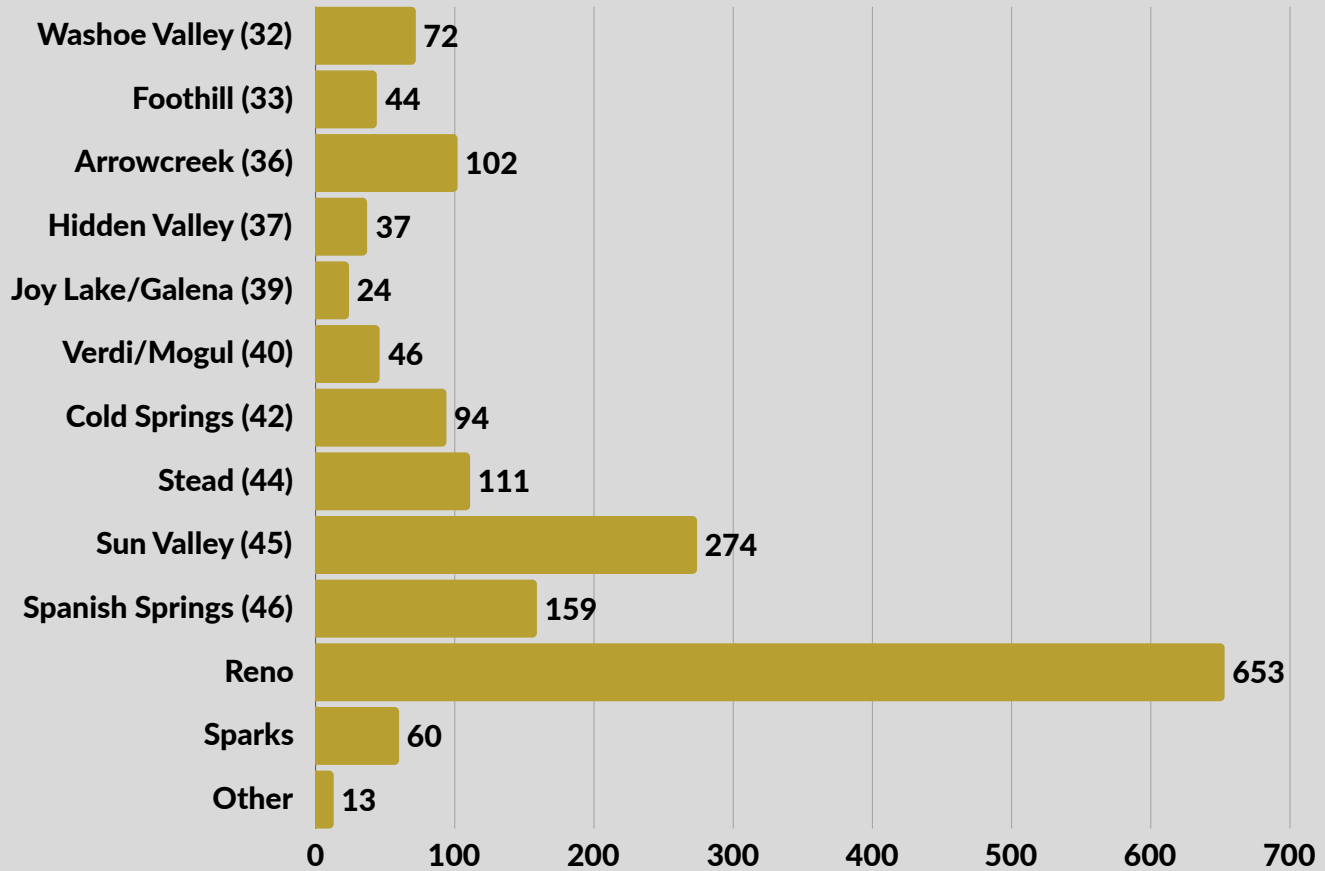

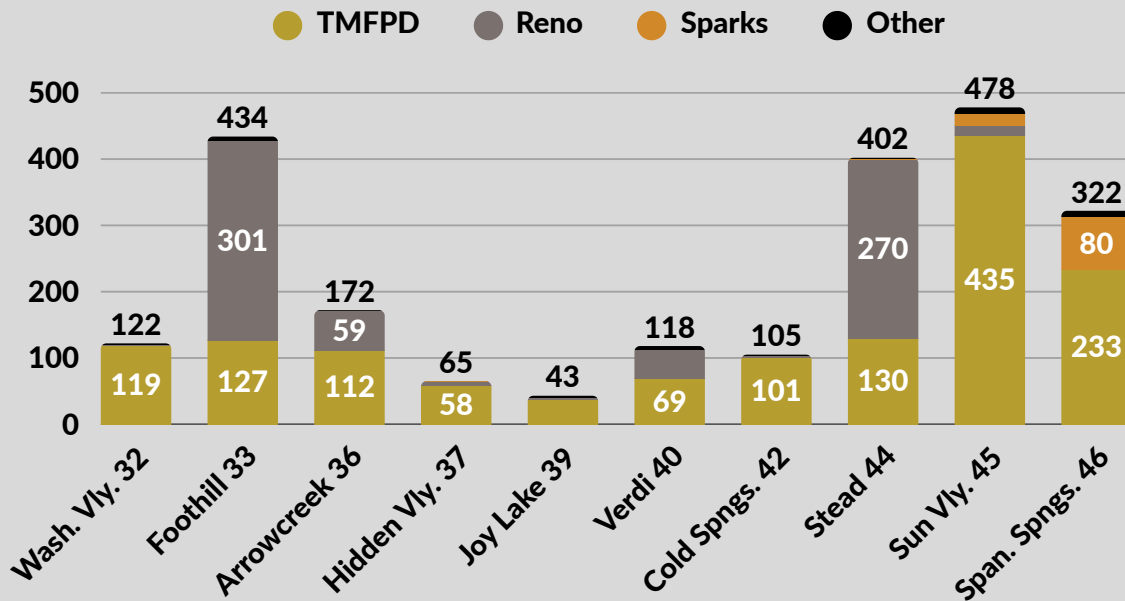

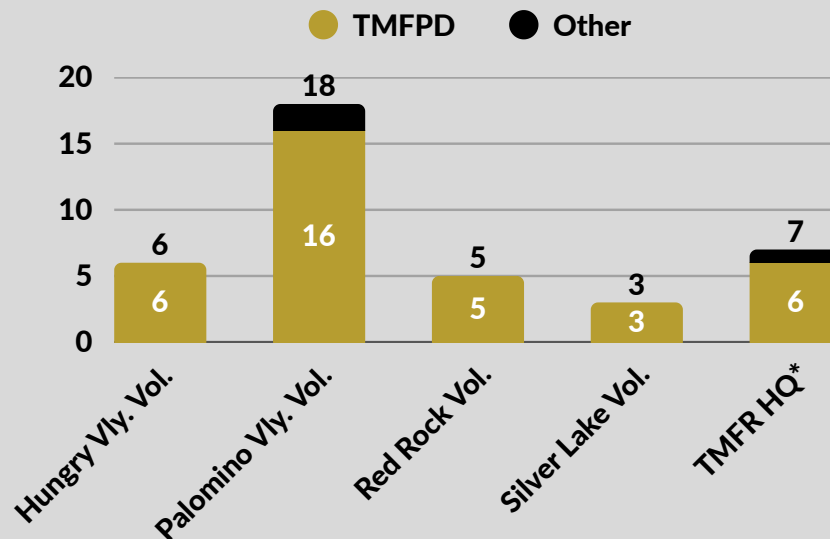
October TM Unit Responses

*HQ includes Wildland Division, Chief officers, and other units not assigned to a station.

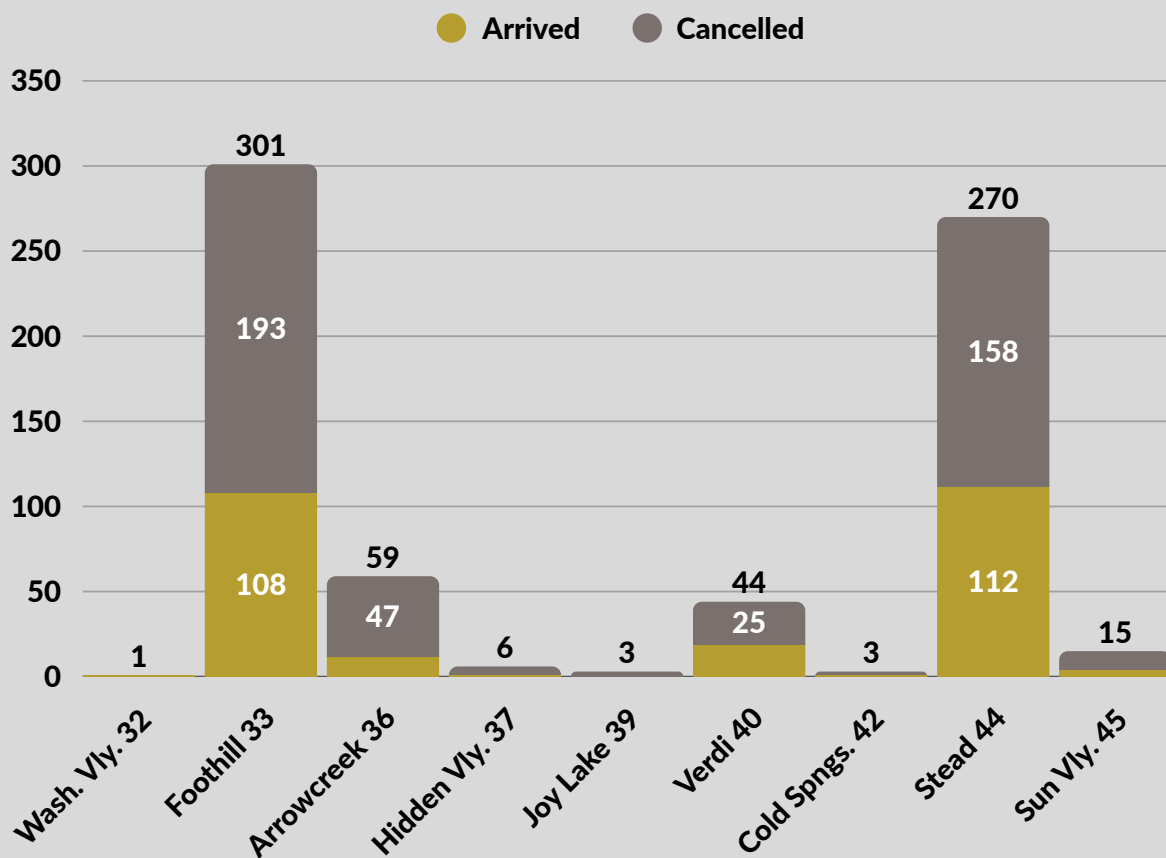

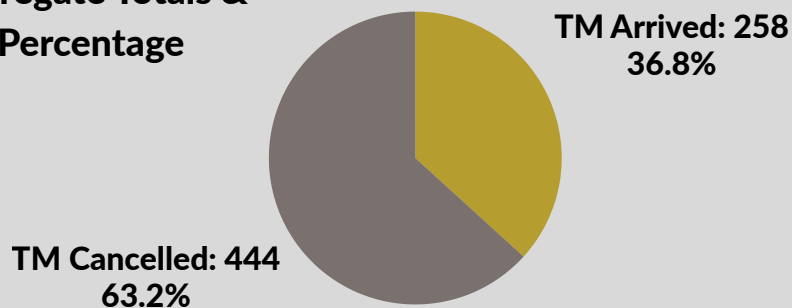

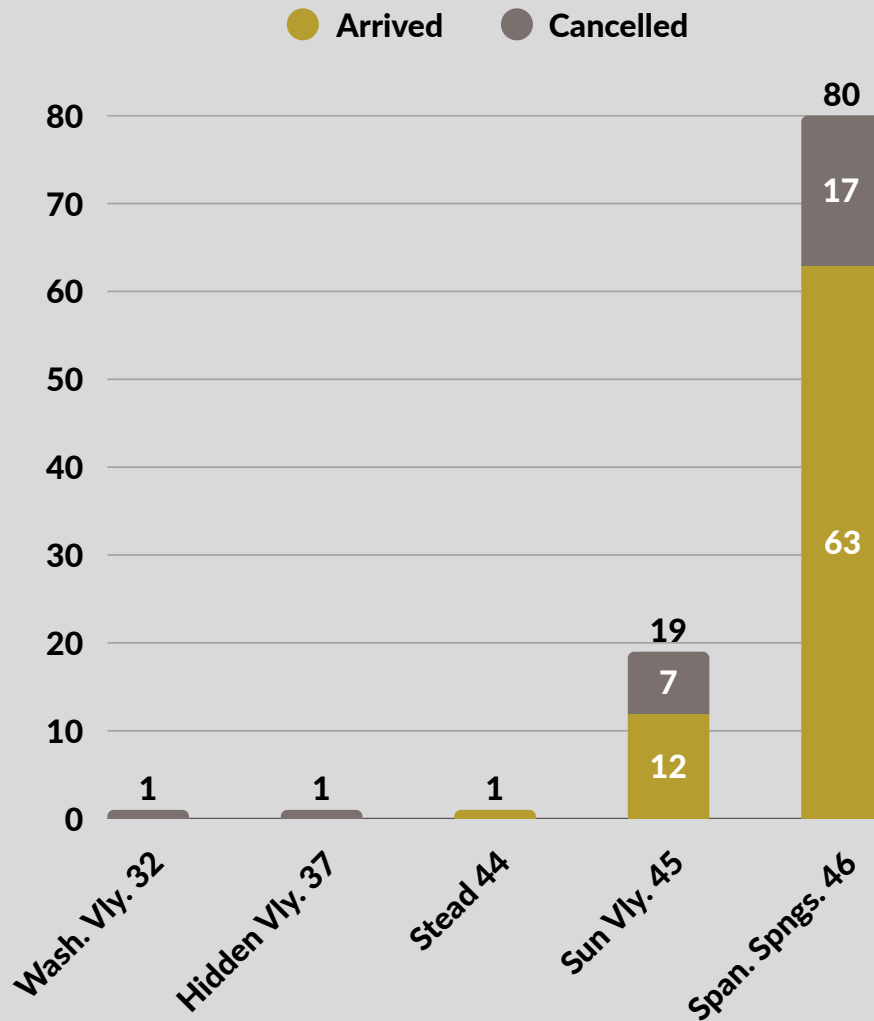
Aggregate Totals & Percentage



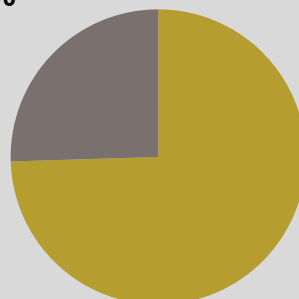

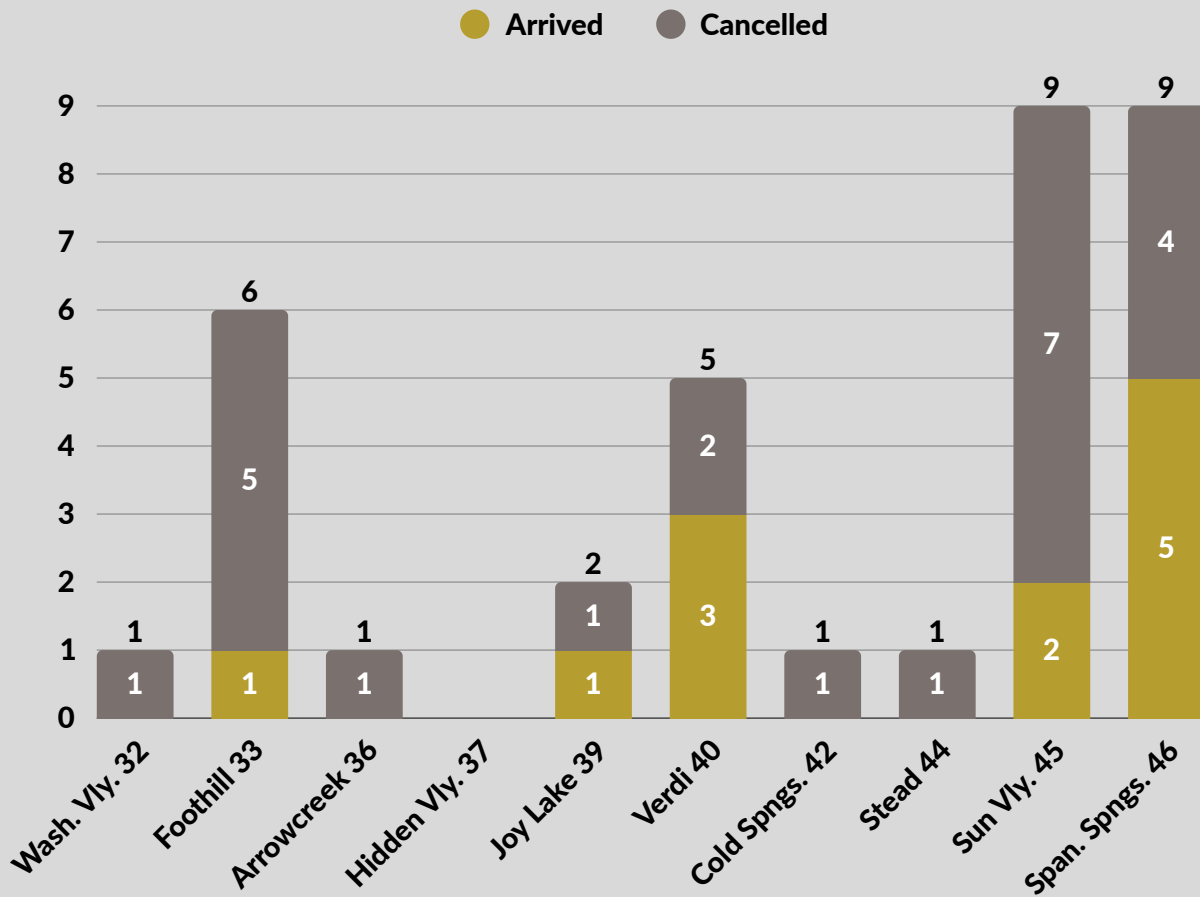

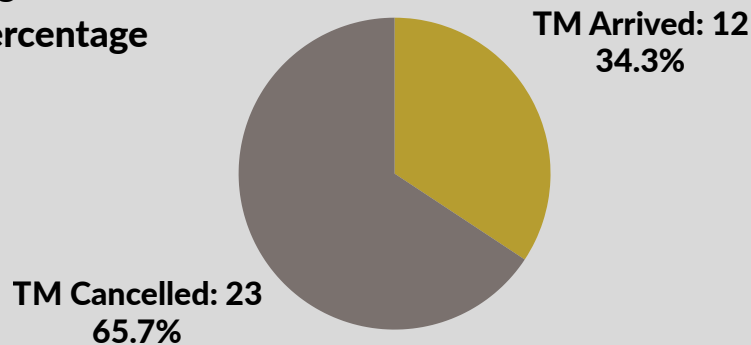

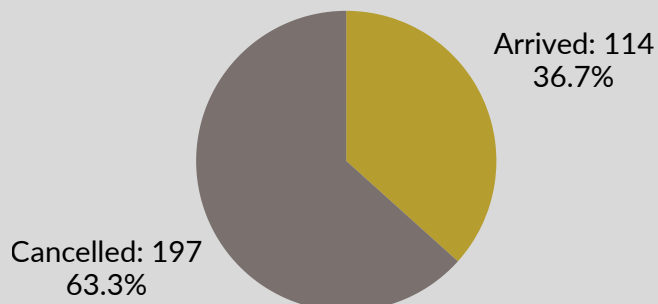
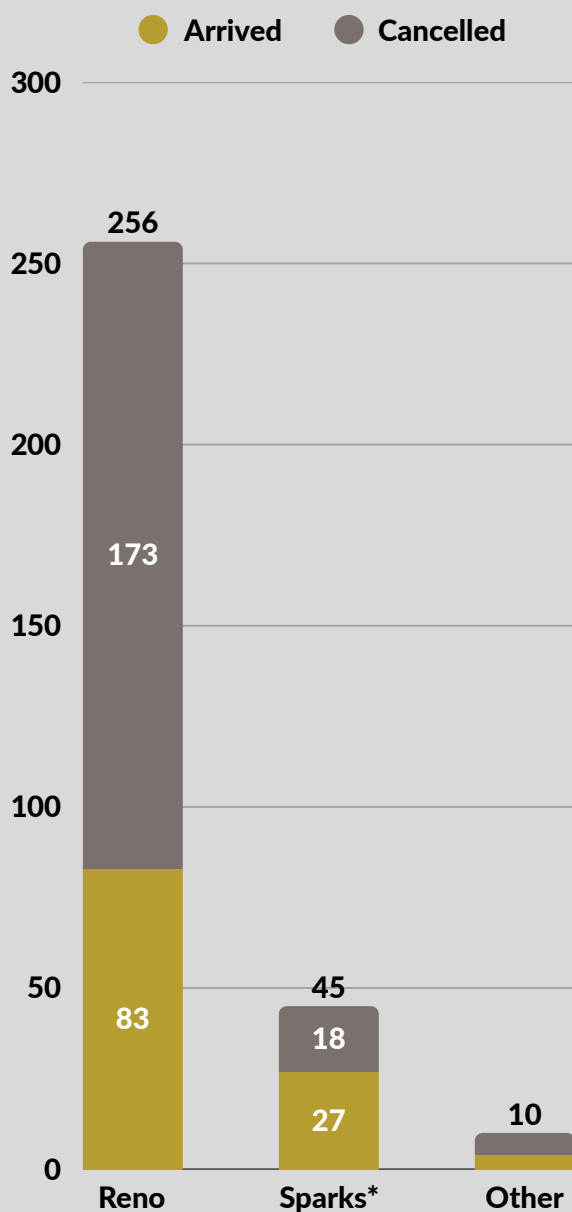
