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### SUMMARY

This item is presented seeking approval to accept the grant award from the Nell J. Redfield Foundation.

Per County policy, the Washoe Board of County Commissioners must accept grant awards and must approve amendments to the adopted fiscal year budget and direct Finance to make the necessary budget amendments.

This grant has been awarded to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office and seeks to implement the HOPE Clean Path Initiative Program. This program will provide food and water as incentives to secure accelerated housing for the homeless population, improve safety and cleanliness for local residents, and reduce rural waste. The HOPE Team provides a unique approach to supporting the unhoused population by focusing on supportive services and resources while trying to divert individuals away from crime and arrests, therefore reducing burden on the criminal justice system.

### PREVIOUS ACTION

No previous action has been taken as this is the first time the Nell J. Redfield Foundation has awarded a grant to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office.

## **BACKGROUND**

This grant will pay for equipment and supply costs incurred for the Homeless Outreach Proactive Engagement (HOPE) Team's Clean Path Initiative.

The HOPE Clean Path Initiative engages homeless individuals in rural Washoe County encampments and incentivizes cooperation with case managers to secure housing. The program provides participants with food and water in exchange for maintaining clean sites and completing tasks toward reaching secure housing, thereby reducing illegal activities such as dumping, camping, and trespassing. Water and food meet survival needs, so these incentives encourage engagement among the unsheltered population and reduce survival-driven crimes.

Anticipated outcomes of the HOPE Clean Path Initiative include improved safety and cleanliness for local residents, reduced rural waste, and accelerated housing for the homeless population. The program also aims to foster a culture of accountability among the unhoused population, tying resources to clean sites, housing progress, and location updates.
