Highlights

- ◆ 11,429 individuals visited the May Arboretum
- ◆ May Arboretum Society held their annual Gala to help raise funds
- ◆ Plated 4 trees in the collection
- ◆ Collaboration with Washoe County Libraries to host story time in Arboretum
- ◆ ¾ time Park Maintenance position open to public

Arboretum Operations

- ◆ 10 weddings occurred in the gardens
- ◆ 28 new trees planted
- ◆ 1 school and 2 private tours participated at the Arboretum
- ◆ 6 memorial bricks sold
- ◆ Irrigation installation of a new backflow that enables better watering coverage for the plants.

- ◆ Hosting of THE COWBOY AND THE WEST art sale featuring the Reno Rodeo Photography of Louis Basso in June
- ◆ Hosting of NEVADA UNBRIDLED art show featuring work from some of Nevada's most prominent artists compiled by May Museum curator Wes Jahn from a private collection.
- ◆ The May Museum boothed at PBS Reno's "BE MY NEIGHBOR" Event at Idlewild Park in July.
- ◆ Hosting of INTO THE WILD art show in the May Museum Gallery presented by Latimer Art Club as part of Artown in July.
- ◆ Hosting of Art Angels program watercolor classes for kids in July.
- ◆ Working with our Park Rangers, Rancho Playroom volunteers once again offered free, themed weeks of crafting and fun in the former Discovery Room June through July.
