### **PREVIOUS ACTION**

On December 9, 2025 the Board of County Commissioners directed a [\$25,000.00] grant to Gerlach Volunteer Fire Department – a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes – to support the fire department and enable it to service the citizens of Gerlach and the surrounding area; and a [\$20,000.00] grant to Food Bank of Northern Nevada - a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes – to support the mission of feeding the hungry in Washoe County; and a

[\$15,000.00] grant to Safe Embrace - a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes – to support the mission of helping victims become survivors

On October 21, 2025 the Board of County Commissioners directed a [\$5,000.00] grant to Senior ResQ - a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes – to support their endeavor to assist seniors with help when their rent has been raised.

On October 14, 2025 the Board of County Commissioners directed a [\$10,000.00] grant to 4-H Youth Development Program of the University of Nevada Extension - a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes - to support the Washoe County 4-H Large Livestock, Horse Programs, and awards at the Nevada State Fair; and a [\$10,000.00] grant to the Washoe County Human Services Agency – a government entity -- to support the Men’s CrossRoads program; and a [\$5,000.00] grant to North Valleys Band Boosters – a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes – to support the North Valleys High School Marching Band program; and a [\$5,000.00] grant to North Valleys High School – a government entity – to support the North Valleys High School JROTC program.

### **BACKGROUND**

Modification of guidelines and adoption of resolution for County Commission District Special Funding on February 10, 2015, created Commission District Special Funds for each Commission District. On May 20, 2025, the Board of County Commissioners approved the 2025-2026 fiscal year budget with special district funds allocated per Commission District in the amount of \$100,000.00. The monies appropriated are to support needs for all Washoe County residents.

Funds appropriated through the Commission District Special Funds must provide substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County. The recipient must be a non-profit organization, created for religious, charitable, or educational purposes, or a government entity. Funds shall not provide any personal or private benefit for the Commissioners, directly or indirectly benefit any campaign efforts by a commissioner, violate Ethics in Government law, or be used to purchase tickets to special events.

Commissioner Herman has elected to support the following organization in fiscal year 2025-2026:

- [\$5,000.00] grant to Reno Elks Charitable Fund - a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes – to support cooking classes for senior citizens focused on preparing meals on a budget.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

Sufficient FY26 budget authority exists within the Cost Center District 5 Constituents (C100105) and account Payments to other Agencies (710400). This action requests approval and distribution of a total of [\$5,000.00] to the following organizations.
