

RESOLUTION: R23-144

Authorizing grant of funds to Experience Education (Brain Health Leadership Foundation)

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities created for religious, charitable or educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County has determined that a certain amount of money is available from the American Rescue Plan Act funds through the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, Assistance Listing #21.027, passed through to Experience Education for the A Pilot Program to Provide EMBP Neuromodulation Therapy in the Treatment Phase of the Washoe County STAR Program will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of Washoe County;

WHEREAS, Experience Education's legal status is as a nonprofit corporation created for educational or charitable purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY, that the Board hereby awards

1. Experience Education, a grant in the amount of \$100,000.
2. The purpose of the SLFRF- ARPA funded program is to enhance mental health treatment services.
3. The maximum amount to be expended from the grant and the conditions and limitations upon the grant are set forth in the Subgrant Agreement.
