PREVIOUS ACTION

On September 19, 2023 the Board acknowledged an item donated totaling an estimated market value of [\$50.00]; and (2) accepted a donation from Grace Community Church, a non-profit religious organization, to Washoe County Human Services Agency Homelessness Fund to support welfare activities in the amount of [\$20,000.00] retroactive for the period July 1, 2023 through July 31, 2023

On August 15, 2023, the Board acknowledged various items donated totaling an estimated market value of [\$4,550.00] retroactive for the period April 15, 2023 through June 30, 2023.

On May 16, 2023, the Board acknowledged various items donated totaling an estimated market value of [\$4,325.00]; and accepted donations from various donors to Washoe County Human Services Agency Homelessness Fund to support welfare activities in the amount of [\$39.00] retroactive for the period February 1, 2023 through April 15, 2023.

On February 21, 2023, the Board acknowledged various items donated totaling an estimated market value of [\$1,325.00]; and accepted donations from various donors to Washoe County Human Services Agency Homelessness Fund to support welfare activities in the amount of [\$10.00] retroactive for the period October 27, 2022 through January 31, 2023.

BACKGROUND

Human Services regularly accepts donations from community members and business, which are for distribution to persons experiencing homelessness. As such, acceptance of donations requires Board approval.

Washoe County Code 15.140(1)(d) reads: 1. The Board of County Commissioners: (d) has sole authority to receive donations of personal property where the personal property has a value, singly or in the aggregate, of \$5,000.00 or greater from a contributor during a fiscal year.

Washoe County Code 15.140(1)(e) reads: 1. The Board of County Commissioners: (e) Must be notified when an officer or employee of a county department or agency accepts non-federal personal property for the use and benefit of the County where the personal property has a value, singly or in the aggregate, of less than \$5,000 from a contributor during a fiscal year. In such event, the officer or employee must notify the Board of County Commissioners in writing of the acceptance.

Washoe County Code 15.160(3) reads: An officer or employee of a county department or agency shall not accept, amend, or supplement a grant, and except as otherwise provided in section 15.140(1)(e), shall not accept, amend, or supplement a contribution of money or property without approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

The Agency is requesting retroactive approval of the following donation that has been received by Homelessness Services for the time period August 1, 2023 through November 15, 2023.

Second Baptist Church – Community Outreach Ministry \$500.00

The following donated items have been received for the period of August 1, 2023 through November 15, 2023, and will need to be retroactively accepted:

- One (1) used Coach handbag received by Human Services Agency donated from an anonymous donor - estimated market value of \$75.00
- One (1) basketball hoop and supplies to build backstop at the Our Place Campus received by Human Services Agency donated from Reno Rotary – estimated market value \$4,500.00
- Ten (10) mattresses and seventeen (17) metal bed frames received by Human Services Agency donated from Eta Iota House Corporation of Delta Gamma – estimated value of \$1,775.00

- One hundred (100) writing journals received by Human Services Agency donated from Joe and Tammy I. – estimated value of \$1,500.00
- Luggage and tote bags received by Human Services Agency donated from Natalie Wood - estimated value of \$80.00

FISCAL IMPACT

Should the Board accept the donation, the Human Services Agency Homelessness Fund (223) FY24 adopted budget will need to be amended by \$500.00 in the following revenue and expenditure accounts.
