

RESOLUTION: R26-000047

Authorizing an award of funds to University of Nevada, Reno – Orvis School of Nursing
WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may

expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities created for religious, charitable or educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County has determined that a certain amount of money is available from the Washoe Opioid Abatement and Recovery Funds (WOARF), award number WOARF27-00002, through the One Nevada Agreement on Allocation of Opioid Recoveries, passed through to University of Nevada, Reno – Orvis School of Nursing for the StreetReach Mobile Health in Action program will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of Washoe County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY, that the Board hereby awards

1. University of Nevada, Reno – Orvis School of Nursing, a grant in the amount of \$499,812.60
2. The purpose of StreetReach Mobile Health in Action (HS) is a nurse-led mobile health initiative designed to expand access to low-barrier, integrated health care for unhoused persons who use or are at risk of OUD. Services include preventive care, primary care, chronic disease management, behavioral health care, substance use treatment, laboratory and diagnostic services, and linkage to dental care.
3. The maximum amount to be expended from the grant and the conditions and limitations upon the award are set forth in Notice of Award WOARF27-00002 that will be signed by the County Manager, or designee.
