SUMMARY

This item is presented seeking approval to accept the grant award from Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI).

Per County policy, the Washoe Board of County Commissioners must accept grant awards and must approve amendments to the adopted fiscal year budget and direct Finance to make the necessary budget amendments.

This grant has been awarded to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office and seeks to enhance the effectiveness of federal/state/local law enforcement resources through a well-coordinated initiative seeking the most effective investigative/prosecutive avenues by which to convict and incarcerate dangerous offenders. The Washoe County Sheriff's Office is a partnering agency in the Safe Streets Task Force initiative.

PREVIOUS ACTION

On May 13, 2025, the Board of County Commissioners approved Item 7.G.1., \$21,740.50 of funding from the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) for activities associated with the Northern Nevada Safe Streets Task Force (NNSSTF) for the retroactive grant period of October 1, 2024, through September 30, 2025.

On November 14, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners approved funding from the FBI for activities associated with the NNSSTF (Item number and amount unavailable).

BACKGROUND

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office has been awarded a grant from the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) to reimburse overtime and benefit costs for deputies assigned full-time to the FBI Northern Nevada Safe Streets Task Force (NNSSTF). The mission of the NNSSTF is to identify and target for prosecution criminal enterprise groups responsible for drug trafficking, money laundering, alien smuggling, crimes of violence such as murder and aggravated assault, robbery, and violent street gangs, as well as to intensely focus on the apprehension of dangerous fugitives where there is or may not be a federal investigative interest.

This grant will pay for overtime costs incurred by staff associated with the NNSSTF for the duration of the grant period through September 30, 2026.

Reason for retroactive submittal: Item was submitted to the first available BCC meeting once documents were received and processed.
