### **TRUCKEE MEADOWS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING OVERTIME AND PORTAL TO PORTAL PAY FOR ALL EMPLOYEES EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026**

**WHEREAS**, the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District is a public agency located in the County of Washoe, State of Nevada; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District's desire to provide fair and legal payment to all its employees for time worked; and

**WHEREAS**, the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District has in its employ, fire department response personnel, including but not limited to, Fire Chief, Deputy Chief, Division Chief, Fire Marshal, Battalion Chief, Fire Captain, Fire Engineer, Firefighter Paramedic, Firefighter EMT, Wildland Battalion Chief, Wildland Captain, Heavy Equipment Operator, Wildland Engine Operator, Wildland Firefighter, WUI Coordinator, Fire Management Officer, Fire Equipment Fleet Manager, EMS Coordinator, Fire Investigator/Inspector, Fire Mechanic, Logistics Coordinator, Logistics Assistant, Accountant AR & Grants Specialist and Volunteer Program Assistant.

**WHEREAS**, the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District will compensate all its employees portal to portal while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station or location and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response; and

**WHEREAS**, the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District will compensate its employees overtime in accordance with their current Labor Agreement, and/or Board approved salaries while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station or location and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response; and

**WHEREAS**, the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District provides mutual aid in accordance with the California Fire Assistance Agreement ("Agreement"), and said agreement provides for reimbursement to the District in the amount expended in connection thereto; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services has requested documentation regarding the District's payment of Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District's personnel with respect to wages earned during the course of an assignment obligated by the Agreement; and the District hereby determines it will provide such documentation.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the conditions set forth in this resolution, as stated above, take effect upon adoption by the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District's Board of Fire Commissioners.
