#### PREVIOUS ACTION

On November 19, 2024, the Board of County Commissioners directed a [\$1,500.00] grant to Northern Nevada Public Health -- a government entity -- to support gift cards to encourage participation in the Aca Entre Nos (AEN) initiative, a series of conversations that addresses mental health and empowers families to take charge of their health.

On August 27, 2024, the Board of County Commissioners directed a [\$3,172.00] grant to Northern Nevada Public Health -- a government entity -- to support the health fees for Dancing in the Streets.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Modification of guidelines and adoption of resolution for County Commission District Special Funding on February 10, 2015, created Commission District Special Funds for each Commission District. On May 21, 2024, the Board of County Commissioners approved the 2024-2025 fiscal year budget with special district funds allocated per Commission District in the amount of \$100,000.00. The monies appropriated are to support needs for all Washoe County residents.

Funds appropriated through the Commission District Special Funds must provide substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County. The recipient must be a nonprofit organization, created for religious, charitable, or educational purposes, or a government entity. Funds shall not provide any personal or private benefit for the Commissioners, directly or indirectly benefit any campaign efforts by a commissioner, violate Ethics in Government law, or be used to purchase tickets to special events.

Commissioner Garcia has elected to support the following organizations in fiscal year 2024-2025:

- [\$10,325.00] grant to Keep Truckee Meadows Beautiful (KTMB) a nonprofit organization created for charitable, religious, or educational purposes for the purpose of supporting the organization's continued partnership with HERO Environmental, who provided hazardous household waste removal for the Sun Valley Drop-Off in November 2024.
- [\$1,000.00] grant to Procter Hug High School a government entity to support the leadership class and their efforts to get the youth involved in the community.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

Sufficient FY24-25 budget authority exists within the Cost Center District 3 Constituents (C100103) and account Payments to other Agencies (710400). This action requests approval and distribution of a [total of \$11,325.00] to KTMB and Procter Hug High School.

Expense Disbursements are required:

• KTMB: \$10,325.00

• Procter Hug High School: \$1,000.00
