SUMMARY

This item is presented seeking approval of the FY25 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Local grant award Certifications and Assurances by the Chief Executive of the Applicant Government and the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Reno, on behalf of the Reno Police Department, and Washoe County, on behalf of the Washoe County Sheriff's Office, for the management and disposition of the FY25 JAG Program Award from the U.S. Department of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance.

The U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance through the City of Reno, Reno Police Department has awarded the Washoe County Sheriff's Office funding for the purchase of Cellebrite digital forensics software for collection, management, and secure sharing of digital evidence and mitigation of cybersecurity threats. This software will support the Washoe County Sheriff's Office Special Operations Division, Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Team.

PREVIOUS ACTION

On June 16, 2026, the Board authorized Item #6.H.5., the award of the 2025 JAG Program through the City of Reno, Reno Police Department (RPD) [\$103,127.50, no

County match required] for purchase of Cellebrite software licenses for the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Team to collect, manage, and securely share digital evidence and mitigate cybersecurity threats.

On June 10, 2025, the Board authorized Item #7.G.4., the award of the 2024 JAG Program through the City of Reno, Reno Police Department (RPD) [\$84,656.80, no County match required] for purchase of law enforcement equipment and supplies and law enforcement-related training and travel.

On December 10, 2024, the Board authorized Item #5.E.3., the grant application for the 2024 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program through the RPD and approved the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Reno, on behalf of the RPD, Washoe County, on behalf of the Washoe County Sheriff's Office (WCSO) and the City of Sparks, on behalf of the Sparks Police Department (SPD).

On March 26, 2024, the Board authorized Item #5.E.2., the award of the 2023 JAG Program through the City of Reno, RPD [\$94,576.00, no County match required] for purchase of law enforcement equipment and supplies and law enforcement-related training and travel.

On November 14, 2023, the Board authorized Item #24, the grant application for the 2023 JAG Program through the RPD and approved the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Reno, on behalf of the RPD, Washoe County, on behalf of the WCSO and the City of Sparks, on behalf of the SPD.

On March 28, 2023, the Board authorized Item #7.F.3, the award of the 2022 JAG Program through the City of Reno, RPD [\$80,704.80, no County match required] for purchase of law enforcement equipment and supplies and law enforcement-related training and travel.

On October 25, 2022, the Board authorized Item #8.F.1., the grant application for the 2022 JAG Program through the RPD and approved the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Reno, on behalf of the RPD, Washoe County, on behalf of the WCSO and the City of Sparks, on behalf of the SPD.

On December 14, 2021, the Board authorized Item #10.K.7., the award of the 2021 JAG Program through the City of Reno, RPD [\$77,956.00, no County match required] for purchase of law enforcement equipment and supplies and law enforcement-related training and travel.

On September 14, 2021, the Board authorized Item #6.G.4., the grant application for the 2021 JAG Program through the RPD and approved the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Reno, on behalf of the RPD, Washoe County, on behalf of the WCSO and the City of Sparks, on behalf of the SPD.

On January 12, 2021, the Board authorized Item #11.H.2, the award of the 2020 JAG Program through the City of Reno, RPD [\$64,502.40, no County match required] for purchase of law enforcement equipment and supplies and law enforcement-related training and travel.

The Board has accepted an annual JAG Local grant award on behalf of the WCSO since 2019.

BACKGROUND

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office and the City of Reno have previously been individual recipients of Block Grant Funds and Byrne Grant Funds. In 2005, the Department of Justice combined both the Byrne Grants and Block Grants into the Justice Assistance Grants (JAG), which require regional applications with one entity acting as fiscal agent of the grant. The City of Reno and Washoe County have agreed that the City of Reno will be the fiscal agent for the JAG grant application.

The Reno Police Department (RPD) submitted the initial application for the known dollar amount of \$206,255.00. With this application, the Washoe County Sheriff's Office (WCSO) was awarded 50% of the total funding, or \$103,127.50, and the RPD was awarded the other 50%, or \$103,127.50. The City of Reno administers the JAG Local grants on behalf of the RPD and WCSO.

Due to a delay in the FY25 grant award, the RPD issued a Letter of Intent to Award this grant agreement that was approved by the Board on June 16, 2026.

This item is presented seeking approval of the FY25 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Local grant award Certifications and Assurances by the Chief Executive of the Applicant Government and the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Reno, on behalf of the Reno Police Department, and Washoe County, on behalf of the Washoe County Sheriff's Office, for the management and disposition of the FY25 JAG Program Award from the U.S. Department of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance. Both documents must be executed before the full award can be issued to the City of Reno, on behalf of the Reno Police Department.

Once the award documents are received, the full award will be taken back to the Board for approval.

This award will fund the Cellebrite subscription from June 9, 2026 through January 10, 2027. The full cost of this subscription is \$105,686.82. The remaining \$2,559.32 of this subscription not covered by this FY25 JAG Local award will come from a FY25 State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program award administered through the Nevada Office of Emergency Management/Homeland Security.

FISCAL IMPACT

Should the Board accept the Certifications and Assurances and the Interlocal Agreement, no adjustments will be needed.

The FY25 OCJA JAG Local award totals [\$103,127.50] for the retroactive period of October 1, 2024, through September 30, 2028. FY26 budget (to be carried forward to FY27) within Internal Order FY25 OCJA JAG Local (IO 12684) has sufficient budget expenditure authority.
