# **SUMMARY**

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office Reserve Deputy Program has received a donation in the amount of \$1,500 for their volunteer efforts at 2024 Cioppino Feed event. This donation will go to support the Reserve Deputy Program, including but not limited to the purchase or repair of equipment, supplies for operations or programming, food and beverage to be used during activations, or training.

# **PREVIOUS ACTION**

The Board has been approving donations from the Boys and Girls Club of Truckee Meadows to the Washoe County Reserve Deputy Program intermittently since 2015.

#### BACKGROUND

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office has a robust Reserve Deputy Program that is supported primarily by community donations. The Reserve Deputy Program is a volunteer program within the Sheriff's Office that provides additional law enforcement resources to supplement full-time deputies. Reserve deputies, while volunteers, are sworn officers working under the supervision of a full-time Washoe County Sheriff's Office deputy. They may assist with routine patrol, special events, and emergencies. These funds will be used to support the program and its volunteer deputies.

# FISCAL IMPACT

Should the Board accept these donations, the Washoe County Sheriff's Office FY26 adopted budget will need to be increased by \$1,500.00 in the following revenue and expenditure accounts.
