purchase a ductless hood, workstations, and a drug library for the

Controlled Substance Section, and purchase toxicology supplies for the retroactive grant period of January 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026 and if approved, authorize Sheriff Balaam to retroactively execute the grant award documentation, and direct the Finance Department to make the

necessary budget amendments. (All Commission Districts.)

SUMMARY

The State of Nevada Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Assistance awarded the Washoe County Sheriff's Office a pass-through grant [\$87,636.00, no County match requirement] 2024 Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement (FSI) grant, Project No. 24-FSI-03 to provide for continued education and training with associated travel for staff members, purchase a ductless hood, workstations, and a drug library for the Controlled Substance Section, and purchase toxicology supplies.

Washoe County Strategic Objectives supported by this item: Fiscal Sustainability – Efficient delivery of regional services, Economic Impacts – Meet the needs of our growing community, and Innovative Services – Leverage technology to streamline and automate.

PREVIOUS ACTION

On March 26, 2024, the Board of County Commissioners approved item #5.F.1., the Sheriff's Office request to approve the acceptance of a pass-through grant award from State of Nevada Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Assistance, Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement (FSI), Project No. 23-FSI-03 for [\$92,325.00 no County match requirement].

On March 28, 2023, the Board of County Commissioners approved item #7F1., the Sheriff's Office request to approve the acceptance of a pass-through grant award from State of Nevada Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Assistance, Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement (FSI), Project No. 22-FSI-03 for [\$90,379.00 no County match requirement].

On February 8, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners approved item #6.F.4., the Sheriff's Office request to approve the acceptance of a pass-through grant award from State of Nevada Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Assistance, Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement [\$117,749.00 no County match requirement].

On January 12, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners approved item #11.H.1., the Sheriff's Office request to approve the acceptance of a pass-through grant award from State of Nevada Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Assistance, Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement [\$77,353.00 no County match requirement].

On January 28, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners approved item #5.D.2., the Sheriff's Office request to approve the acceptance of a pass-through grant award from State of Nevada Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Assistance, Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement [\$54,027.00 no County match requirement].

On March 12, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners approved item #13, the Sheriff's Office request to approve acceptance of a pass-through grant award from State of Nevada Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Assistance, Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement [\$177,189.00 with an \$11,285.00 County match requirement].

The Board has approved the Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement (FSI) grant awards annually since 2008.

BACKGROUND

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office Forensic Science Division will utilize these funds to improve quality and timeliness of forensic services through training on robotic applications. Funding will be used to provide enhanced courtroom testimony training to new and existing staff and provide leadership training for lab management. In addition to training and travel, the grant will be used to purchase a ductless hood and workstations to provide safer work environments for the Controlled Substance staff and to update an instrument library used for drug testing to ensure our laboratory has up-to-date drug information. The funds will also be used to purchase operating supplies for the Toxicology section.

Reason for retroactive submittal: Item was submitted to the first available BCC meeting once all paperwork was received and processed.
