EMS UPDATES

AHA Rural Funding Initiative

The Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District (TMFPD) has officially partnered with the American Heart Association (AHA) in a new rural funding initiative. Through this program, the district will receive \$3,000 annually to enhance coordination with regional hospitals, focusing specifically on improving outcomes for stroke and chest pain emergencies. This funding will strengthen communication protocols and data-sharing between first responders and emergency department staff, ensuring critical, life-saving care begins the moment crews arrive on scene.

New EMS Coordinator Hired

In tandem with this initiative, TMFPD is expanding its leadership team with the hiring of a new EMS Coordinator, who is scheduled to officially start on July 27th. This role will be pivotal in managing the district's evolving clinical programs, overseeing specialized training, and streamlining the newly funded hospital coordination efforts.

Advanced Department Training

To maintain the highest standards of field mentorship, the department recently conducted a comprehensive Field Training Officer (FTO) "Train the Trainer" course. This program was designed to equip both new and existing FTOs with advanced instructional skills to effectively guide incoming recruits.

Additionally, personnel completed specialized training in bleeding and clotting management, updating crews on the latest advanced techniques to control severe hemorrhaging and stabilize critical trauma patients in the field.
