SUMMARY

Accept donations in the amount of \$1,435.24 in cash from various businesses, organizations and individuals and in-kind donations [estimated value \$200.00] from the Ray and Barbara Fretz for Regional Parks and Open Space programs and facilities, retroactive to date of receipt.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Fiscal Sustainability: Long-term sustainability.

PREVIOUS ACTION

Donations are made to the Regional Parks and Open Space programs and facilities and formally accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.

BACKGROUND

The residents of Washoe County support our parks, open space and natural resources through their generous cash contributions, donations of materials, supplies and services and volunteer time. Cash donations, in the amount of \$1,435.24 and in-kind donations [estimated value \$200.00], have been received for park maintenance, improvements, programming, and to assist with the safety and comfort for Washoe County residents, therefore, retroactive approval to accept these donations is being sought.

Cash donations received at this time are dedicated to general donations to the Come In From The Cold at Bartley Ranch Park, Bowers Mansion Iron Ranger, general donations to the May Museum, May Arboretum garden memorial brick, maintenance, and improvements.
