SUMMARY

This staff report is to approve updated mitigation rates for the deployment of emergency services provided/rendered by Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District and collected through the existing service agreement with Fire Recovery USA, LLC to assist with the billing of these services as per previous Resolution TM09-2021 (Attachment 1) and the corresponding updated "Exhibit A".

PREVIOUS ACTION

June 1, 2021, the Board of Fire Commissioners approved resolution TM09-2021 amending a district program charging mitigation rates for the deployment of emergency services provided/rendered by the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District.

April 20, 2020, the Board of Fire Commissioners approved an Ambulance Transport Rate Schedule for Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District for emergency responses to motor vehicle accidents.

BACKGROUND

Following the passage of resolution TM09-2021, the District entered into a contract with Fire Recovery USA, LLC to collect mitigation fees. Fire Recovery USA, LLC has continually fulfilled its obligations and made appropriate rate adjustments outlined by the contract. It is good practice to amend and update Exhibit A periodically to ensure transparency with current adjusted

rates. Mitigation fees have been recovered at an average rate of 87% of all submitted invoices for an average of \$55,563 per fiscal year.

Statutory Authority: NRS 474.550 allows the District to recover expenses for responding to certain emergencies in its jurisdiction. Most motor vehicle insurance, which is required for all drivers in the State, already includes coverage for deployment of emergency services. The District would like to update “Exhibit A” to reflect the most current rates being applied to this program.

FISCAL IMPACT

All receipts received are deposited into the District’s General Fund and used for Emergency Operations.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve updated mitigation rates for the deployment of emergency services provided/rendered by the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District and collected through the existing service agreement with Fire Recovery USA, LLC to assist with the billing of these services as per previous Resolution TM09-2021 and the corresponding updated “Exhibit A”.
