

**RESOLUTION: R26-000024**

Authorizing transfer and subgrant to University of Nevada, Reno

**WHEREAS**, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities created for religious, charitable or educational purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County has previously approved the use of American Rescue Plan Act funds through the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund to purchase a Mobile Medical and Command Vehicle to support public health outreach and service delivery; and

**WHEREAS**, due to operational constraints, Northern Nevada Public Health has had limited ability to fully utilize the asset, and the County has determined that transferring the asset to another governmental entity will ensure its continued use for an eligible public health purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the University of Nevada, Reno's legal status is as a governmental agency, capable of operating and maintaining the asset in compliance with applicable federal requirements, including SLFRF and Uniform Guidance (2CFR 200.313); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds that the transfer and continued use of this asset to expand access to preventative care, health screenings, and outreach services for underserved populations will provide a substantial benefit to Washoe County residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY**, that the Board hereby awards

1. University of Nevada, Reno, a subgrant for the transfer and continued use of a Mobile Medical and Command Vehicle (VIN: 1F66F5KN0A12432).
2. The purpose of this agreement is to ensure the continued use of the asset to support eligible public health activities, including expanding access to preventative care, medical screenings, and outreach services to underserved populations in Washoe County.
3. This award consists of the transfer of a Mobile Medical and Command Vehicle originally purchased with SLFRF funds at a total cost of \$575,498. Title to the vehicle shall vest with the University of Nevada, Reno upon execution of the agreement.

4. The terms, conditions, and requirements governing the use, management, and compliance of the asset are set forth in the Subgrant Agreement that will be signed by the County Manager.
